Scoping Period Concludes for East San Fernando Valley Transit Project

Monday, May 6, 2013 was the last day to provide scoping comments for the East San Fernando Valley Transit Corridor. Scoping is the first step in the environmental review process. More than 220 comments were received including verbal and written comments at the scoping meetings held in March, and those that have come in since by mail, e-mail and social media. They come from a wide variety of commenters including members of the general public, businesses and business groups, neighborhood and community organizations, public agencies and elected officials. The project team is reviewing the input that will be used to help shape the Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report (Draft EIS/EIR) that is evaluating transit improvement options primarily along the Van Nuys Boulevard corridor between Ventura Boulevard and the Sylmar/San Fernando Metrolink Station. We are planning additional community meetings later this year.
