



WESTSIDE SUBWAY EXTENSION

Seismic Testing Fact Sheet

Metro contractors will be conducting seismic investigations as a part of the planning and environmental analysis for the proposed Westside Subway Extension.

Where/When: City of Los Angeles (10PM – 6AM Weekdays Only)

- January 12 & 13: Beginning on Century Park West at the parking entrance for 1930 Century Park West and concluding on Warnall at Eastborne
- January 14 & 15: Beginning on Selby Avenue mid-way between La Grange & Missouri and concluding on Selby at North Temple Way

What to Expect:

- A crew of up to 6 people.
- Moderate noise and vibration.
- A "minivib" truck (see photo). Any additional passenger vehicles will be parked in legal parking spaces.
- All work will be done on the east side of the streets being tested.
- Parking lane and/or 1 lane of traffic will be blocked while work is under way.
- Residents who live on the east side of the effected block of Warnall will need to travel south-bound to access their driveways.
- Access to the Westfield mall will be restricted to the entrances at Santa Monica Boulevard and Constellation Avenue
- Traffic on Santa Monica Boulevard will be reduced to one lane in each direction on each night of testing.
- Lanes will be cleared at the end of the work period and re-opened for regular use.



Why is Metro Doing This Work At This Time?

- Metro is preparing a Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report for the proposed Westside Subway Extension.
- This work is being done in order to assess the conditions below the ground surface in order to prepare the necessary plans.

Note: Metro is still evaluating multiple route options for the subway tunnels between stations at Century City and Westwood. No decisions or determinations about this have been made. Data gathered from seismic evaluation will be a part of making that determination.

Other Important Information

- All work has received necessary permits and approvals.
- It may be necessary to conduct additional field work a few weeks following this testing. If this is necessary, we will inform the area(s) where this work will take place.
