

As a reminder, in order to install rail across Barrington Avenue for the Expo Line project, the design-build contractor SRJV will need to implement a **full weekend closure** starting tomorrow **Friday, August 8 at 9:00 p.m.**

What: Full Weekend Closure of Barrington Avenue

When: Continuous Closure - 9:00 p.m., Friday, August 8 to 6:00 a.m., Monday, August 11, 2014

Work Hours: Continuous work hours

Where: Barrington Avenue, between Olympic Boulevard and Tennessee Avenue

Traffic Impacts:

- Barrington Avenue will be temporarily closed between Olympic Boulevard and Tennessee Avenue. Please follow detour signs for alternate routes.
- Exposition Boulevard, both north and south of the Expo Right-of-Way, will be temporarily closed at Barrington Avenue.
- Local access in the closure areas will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained on the east side of Barrington Avenue only.
- Electronic message boards, directional signage and flaggers will be used to direct vehicles and pedestrians around the construction zone.

Advisories:

- Noise levels will be monitored to ensure work performed is within the necessary compliance levels. Sound blankets will be installed if required to buffer any noise that may impact the surrounding community.
- Work crews will water down the work area to minimize dust, sweep adjacent streets of debris as needed, and will monitor the air.
- Parking restrictions will be strictly enforced at all times and signage with specific restrictions will be in place in all construction areas.
- Please obey all posted construction signs and do not enter the construction work zone.
