



In-Roadway Warning Lights Project - Gold Line, Eastside

3rd Street at Gage Avenue/Eastbound I-60 Freeway On-Ramp Weekdays, February 17-19, 2015

SUMMARY

The In-Roadway Warning Lights Project involves the installation of in-roadway warning lights and related facilities at ten (10) grade crossings on the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension, and two (2) grade crossings on the Metro Blue Line.

The in-roadway warning lights are intended to re-enforce existing traffic control devices and increase the public's awareness of Metro train operations at these intersections.

During the months of February through July, 2015 Metro crews will conduct road work to install these rail crossing improvements at selected Metro Gold and Blue Line intersections.

ESSENTIALS

What: In-Roadway Warning Lights work, Metro Gold Line, Eastside.

When: Weekdays, February 17 - 19, 2015, 9 am to 3 pm.

Where: 3rd Street at Gage Avenue/Eastbound I-60 Freeway On-Ramp.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be safely routed through or around the construction area.

Posted speed limit through construction area is 35 MPH.

Minimum 11' lane width will be maintained during day work.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.

NOTEWORTHY

The majority of work will be performed during normal day hours however some work will occur at night.

Day work, between the hours of 9am – 3pm, Metro crews will implement temporary lane closures near intersections where lights are being installed.

Night work, between the hours of 9pm – 6am, will involve full street closures in the vicinity of the project.
