Removal and Reconstruction of Soundwall

What

Crews will remove and reconstruct a section of soundwall along northbound I-5 in Burbank.

Where

The affected segment is on northbound I-5, between Jackson Street and Keystone Street.

When

The existing soundwall will be removed the night of April 22. Reconstruction of the wall will begin immediately after removal and take about five months, finishing in August 2015. Most work will occur during the day, 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Why

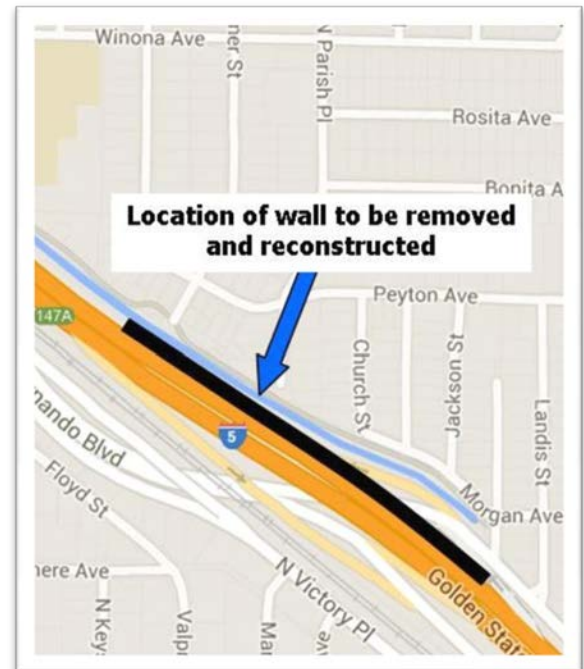
This work is necessary to widen I-5 to construct new carpool lanes, which are part of the I-5 Empire Project.

What to Expect

Residents who live near I-5 may hear some construction noise. This is normal and expected for an operation of this nature. Sound blankets will be used to reduce noise impacts.

Expedited Schedule

To minimize impacts in the adjacent neighborhood, the construction schedule has been revised, allowing the total duration of this operation, originally expected to take a full year, to be reduced by seven months.

The I-5 Empire Project is a series of improvements to I-5 in Burbank between Magnolia Boulevard and Buena Vista Street, including: carpool lanes, elevated railroad tracks, reconfigured ramps, a new interchange at Empire Avenue, widening of the Burbank Boulevard Bridge, and more.
