1. Questions received from potential Proposers prior to Pre-Proposal meeting

Question #1: It is indicated that "A minimum of 10 terminals in system accept walk-up renters..." however in exhibit C – Pricing Schedule (Page 5-16 to 5-18) we only have the option to price as many kiosks indicated in the form which is equivalent to the number of stations.

- a) Kiosks and terminals reference 2 different elements of the station or are they the same thing. Where a kiosk can be an instructional and publicity fixture and a terminal is a payment interface for walk-up users.
- b) We can modify the kiosk/terminal quantity pre-listed on pages 5-16 top 5-18?
- c) We must provide as many kiosk/terminals as listed on pages 5-16 to 5-18?

Answer #1:


- a) In Exhibit C, Metro is referring to kiosks as the element that includes a payment terminal and/or information about the system. If you are providing informational kiosks without a payment terminal element explain that in your proposal.
- b) Yes, you may modify the kiosk/terminal quantity as long as the amount of bikes stays the same as requested.
- c) Yes, you may provide as few as 10 walk up terminals.
