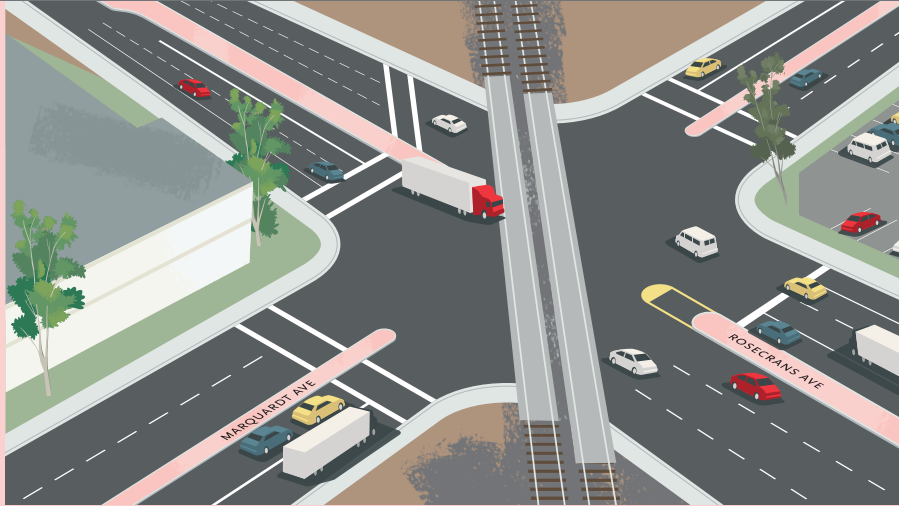
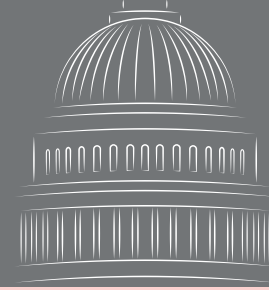


# Federal Funding 2016 TIGER/FASTLANE Discretionary Award Rosecrans/Marquardt Grade Separation Project



- > Metro is partnering with the BNSF Railway, the City of Santa Fe Springs, the California High Speed Rail Authority and Caltrans to grade separate the Rosecrans Avenue and Marquardt Avenue intersection in Los Angeles County.
- > The Rosecrans Avenue and Marquardt Avenue Grade Separation Project will substantially enhance safety and traffic flow, including truck and vehicular circulation, on surface streets – along with improving the efficiency of train movement along this busy rail corridor.
