## FLOOR ALERT SUPPORT - AB 2321 (FEUER)

### PROVISIONS

AB 2321 would update Metro's existing authority to place a one-half cent sales tax on the ballot. AB 2321 would amend Metro's authorization by:

- Extending the term of the sales tax from 6 ½ years to up to 30 years;
- Retaining the existing project list and requiring that the funding allocations be minimum guarantees;
- Requiring Metro to update project completion dates;
- Requiring that all projects funded from the sales tax proceeds be incorporated in Metro's Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) as priority projects;
- Requiring Metro to use the excess sales tax proceeds, beyond the funds needed for the projects to implement projects in the LRTP.

### BACKGROUND

If approved by voters, the measure would provide funding for transportation projects and programs in Los Angeles County. In light of dwindling state and federal transportation dollars, the sales tax would provide Metro with an alternative revenue option to finance critical transportation projects in the county.

AB 2321 would provide Metro with the resources to implement the LRTP. Without these funding resources, Metro's ability to expand our transit and highway system is severely limited.
