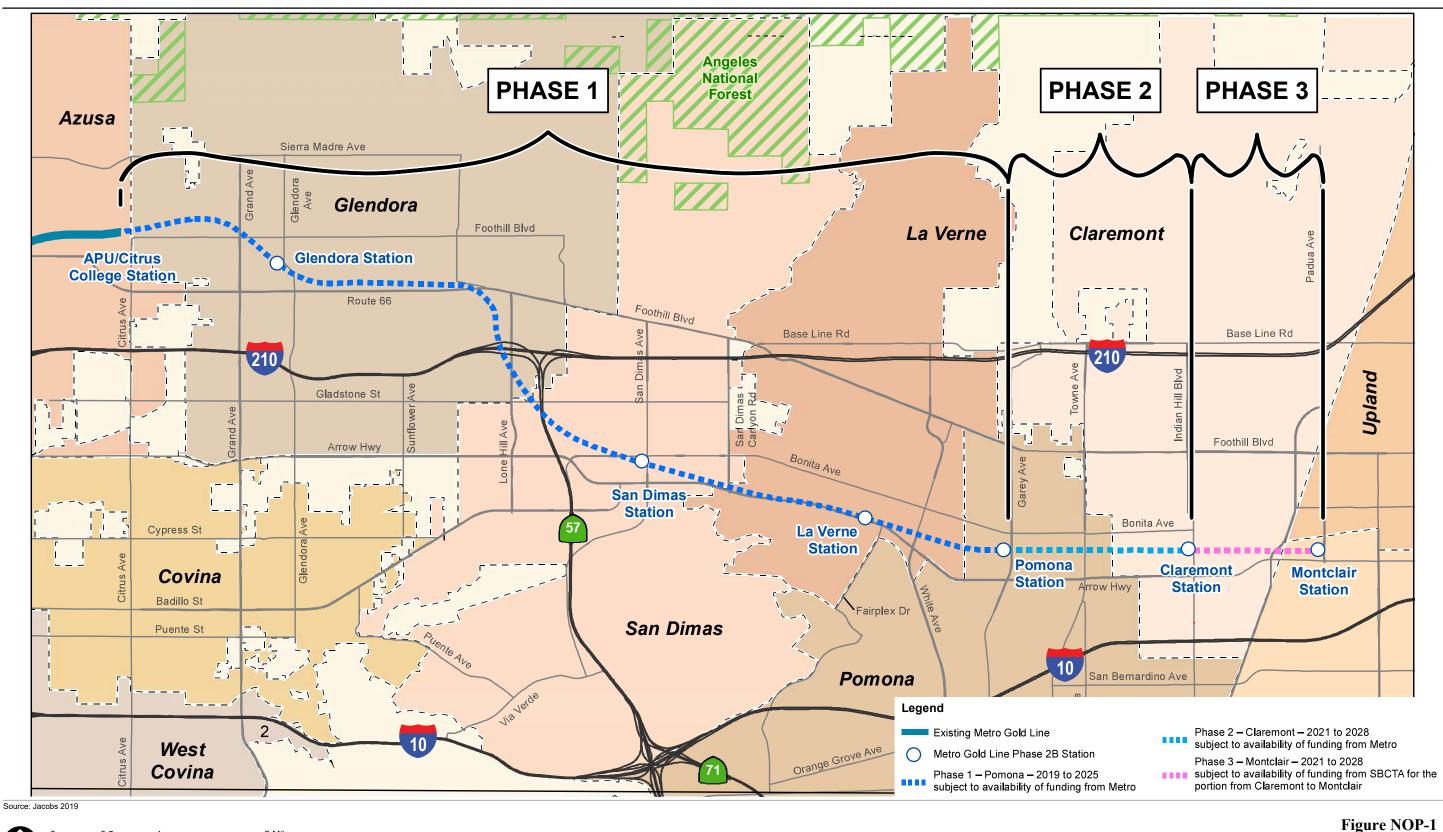
Phase 2B of the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension (Project) is a 12.3-mile extension of the existing Metro Gold Line Light Rail Transit line from its current terminus in the City of Azusa, located in Los Angeles County, to the Montclair Transcenter, located in San Bernardino County. See map of project location in Figure NOP-1. In 2013, the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority ("Authority") certified a Final Environmental Impact Report ("FEIR") and approved the Project. A detailed description of the Project is included in the FEIR and four addenda there to adopted by the Authority (State Clearinghouse No. 2010121069). In 2019, the Authority certified a Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) to the 2013 FEIR which addressed changes to the phasing of construction and operation of the Project and identified a new traffic/transportation mitigation measure. In 2021, the Authority also certified the 2021 SEIR to the 2013 FEIR and subsequent environmental actions, which addressed modifications to construct surface parking lots (instead of enclosed parking structures, as previously approved) at the Glendora, San Dimas, La Verne, and Pomona Stations. (Cont. from Project Description) On June 17, 2021, the City of San Dimas in cooperation with the Construction Authority approved a binding letter of intent to relocate the San Dimas parking lot. Parking for the San Dimas Station would be relocated from the location approved in the 2021 SEIR to a new location south of the project right-of-way between Monte Vista Avenue and San Dimas Avenue (NOP-2). The proposed new location is currently used as an existing San Dimas Park & Ride lot for Foothill Transit. The proposed new location would be redeveloped to accommodate the same number of parking spaces as identified for the approved parking location in San Dimas. The Authority also proposes new roadway and pedestrian access to the San Dimas Station. The approved parking facility assessed in the 2021 SEIR was located two blocks east along Arrow Highway, south of the project right-of-way and west of Walnut Avenue (NOP-3). No modifications are proposed for the parking facilities at the Glendora, La Verne, Pomona, Claremont, and Montclair Stations. In response to these proposed changes, the Authority will be initiating the preparation of a SEIR to evaluate the potential for significant impacts that may result from the proposed changes at the San Dimas Station.





Draft SEIR3/Notice of Availability Outreach Documentation Memo July 7, 2022

This memo, and associated Appendix, documents the public and agency outreach conducted for the Notice of Availability (NOA) of the Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Report 3 (SEIR3). Outreach included direct email to the most interested stakeholders, and a toolkit provided to corridor agencies and groups to spread the word. General notification was also provided through the monthly agency E-News Update distribution and social media platforms. Information was included on the agency website and an announcement was included on the homepage to make it easy to find the Draft SEIR3 on the website and for interested stakeholders to learn how and by when to provide comments. Finally, legal ads were placed in two regional newspapers. Below are details on all outreach conducted:

Public and Agency Outreach

The Notice of Availability (attached in Appendix A) was distributed to members of the public and agencies starting on February 18, 2022, via direct email and the agency's monthly E-News publication. Emailed recipients included all stakeholders who had previously registered to attend the October 26, 2021 SEIR3 Virtual Scoping Meeting; along with a list of state, regional and local agencies (listed in Table 1). Additionally, the agency sent a broad notification out as part of the monthly E-News update in February 2022 to the more than 13,000 registered stakeholders. A copy of the email and E-News notifications are included in Appendix B.









Figure 1-2 San Dimas Alternative Parking Lot Site Plan



In 2019, the Construction Authority certified a Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (SEIR 1) to the 2013 FEIR which addressed changes to the phasing of construction and operation of the Project and identified a new traffic/transportation mitigation measure. Construction Authority certified a second Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (SEIR 2) in January 2021 which addressed the reduction and reconfiguration of parking facilities at five stations (Glendora, San Dimas, La Verne, Pomona, and Claremont). The Construction Authority is considering modifications to the Project as approved in the 2013 FEIR, its addenda, the 2019 SEIR (SEIR 1) and the 2021 SEIR (SEIR 2).

Proposed Project Modifications

The Construction Authority is considering modifications to the Project to relocate the proposed parking facility at the San Dimas Station from the previously approved location to a new location south of the project right-of-way between Monte Vista Avenue and San Dimas Avenue - the site is the current San Dimas Park and Ride Lot. The Project Modifications are proposed as a result of coordination conducted between the City of San Dimas and the Construction Authority. Approximately 289 parking spaces would be provided which is consistent with the number of parking spaces planned at the currently approved facility as part of SEIR 2. Relocation of the San Dimas parking facility would result in associated vehicle and pedestrian access changes in the vicinity of the San Dimas Station. All parking modifications would be designed and constructed in accordance with the Metro Rail Design Criteria. In response to these proposed changes, the Authority has prepared a SEIR (SEIR 3) to evaluate the potential for significant impacts that may result from the potential relocation of the San Dimas parking facility.

The proposed changes do not alter the scope of the Project as approved by the Construction Authority. The Draft SEIR 3 has concluded construction of the Project Modifications would not have new or more severe significant impacts or require new mitigation measures.

No modifications are proposed for the parking facilities at the Glendora, La Verne, Pomona, Claremont, or Montclair Stations

Public Review and Comment Period

The Draft SEIR 3 is being made available for public review for a 45-day comment period, from Friday, February 18, 2022 through Monday, April 4, 2022. Public comments on the Draft SEIR 3 will be received during this period. 




