California State Senate Adopts SB 1026

The California State Senate moved this afternoon to adopt SB 1026 authored by Senator Sheila Kuehl (D-Santa Monica). The legislation would, if signed into law by the Governor, allow the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (in close coordination with Caltrans) to use the design-build contracting method for the planned construction of a High Occupancy Vehicle lane on the northbound I-405 freeway between I-10 and U.S. 101. The bill was adopted by a vote of 12-2 in the Senate Transportation & Housing Committee and later was passed by a margin of 28-8 on the Senate floor. The measure will now be transmitted to the Governor for his consideration.

Exposition Metro Line Construction Authority Board Meeting

The Exposition Metro Line Authority Construction Board is scheduled to meet on Thursday, January 12, 2006 at 2:30 p.m. at the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 3rd floor, Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room 381B.

Under General Board Actions, the Board will consider staff's recommendation to approve the project budget and the staffing plan for fiscal year 2006, the personnel policy and employment manual, the employee pension and deferred compensation plan, and amendments to the administrative code. The Board will also receive a monthly project status update.
