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Street Closure Impact on Metro Bus Service

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A Los Angeles Times reporter requested information on how much Metro spent due to street closures in the Hollywood area. The reporter focused on the Academy Awards, a Verizon Concert (Hollywood/Vine) and the Triathlon. Media Relations explained the planning and operations cost of each event. Total labor cost for the three events was \$19,660, which does not include operator overtime, printing and fuel costs. A total of 86 Metro Bus lines were rerouted for these events and the Metro Red Line Hollywood/Highland Station was closed the day of the Academy Awards. A story will run in tomorrow's edition.

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
