## Metro Blue Line Service Delays

Media Relations staff responded to numerous media inquires regarding an incident that occurred near the Metro Blue Line early this morning when a truck traveling on the 91 Freeway went out of control and ran off the freeway, hitting the overhead power lines of the Metro Blue Line. As a result, the Metro Blue Line experienced major service delays throughout the day as work crews continue to repair the damaged overhead power lines. It may take up to 48 hours to completely repair the damage caused by the accident. Metro Blue Line trains are running approximately 15 to 30 minutes late. North and south bound trains are currently sharing one track between the Imperial and Del Amo stations. As an alternate to Metro Rail, commuters can ride Metro Bus Lines 60/360 between Long Beach and downtown Los Angeles.
