A reporter from the Chinese TV station Phoenix Satellite Television asked today for a Metro response to the Chinese Cultural Historic Society's accusation of hiding information on the discovery of human remains during construction of a retaining wall for the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension. Metro staff explained to the reporter that Metro informed the Chinese community in a timely manner after we got the lab report from the archeologist in charge of the excavation and that the remains are from a wide variety of ethnic backgrounds, not only Chinese.
