Congresswoman Roybal-Allard Tours Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension Construction Site

Congresswoman Lucille Roybal-Allard (D-34) donned her safety equipment and visited our two giant tunnel boring machines - Lola and Vicki during a tour of the Eastside construction site this afternoon. Eastside Project Director Dennis Mori and Underground Construction Project Manager Eli Chouiery provided the Congresswoman with both an overview of the project's status and a brief review of the state-of-the-art tunnel boring technology that we are employing on the Eastside Project.

As of yesterday, the eastbound tunnel boring machine, Vicki, had advanced 120 feet from the 1st/Boyle Mariachi Plaza site. Congresswoman Roybal-Allard was able to walk 120 feet into the tunnel through the 344 feet long tunnel boring machine and observe soil being transported through muck cars and precast concrete tunnel liner segments being installed. I was pleased to inform her about the Eastside Project Team safety record of 623 days without a single lost time accident since the start of construction.

Congresswoman Roybal-Allard was encouraged by the progress we have registered on the Eastside Project and she is working hard to ensure that the Eastside Project receives, consistent with our Full Funding Grant Agreement, \$100 million in federal funds this year.
