March And Rally Set For Tomorrow In Downtown Los Angeles

There is a planned mass march and rally scheduled for tomorrow in downtown Los Angeles to protest a bill (HR 4427) that would amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to strengthen enforcement of the immigration laws. The planned march will start at Broadway and Olympic and proceed to City Hall. Service delays are anticipated on a total of 55 Metro operated bus lines that will need to be detoured beginning at 10 a.m. tomorrow. Media relations responded to numerous media inquires today regarding the impacts on Metro Bus service as a result of the planned rally.
