Quarterly Legislative Briefing for Federal and State Staff

Metro Government Relations has scheduled the next Quarterly Legislative Briefing for federal and state legislative staff on Friday, April 21st. The briefing will be held from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the Windsor Conference Room at Gateway headquarters. Briefing topics will include the status of our Long Range Transportation Plan, Labor Negotiations, Metro's Joint Development Program and the proposed State Infrastructure Bonds.

Media Relations issued a news release today encouraging patrons to take the Metro System to various Earth Day activities that are planned for April 22. By taking Metro, people can leave their cars at home and use transit to attend the many events planned in celebration of Earth Day.

Of Note

On this date in 2002 Los Angeles celebrated the opening of the Alameda Corridor project. After more than two decades of planning and five years of construction, the \$2.4 billion Alameda Corridor freight rail expressway officially opened and began to speed the flow of cargo to and from the nation's two busiest ports. Metro provided \$358.7 million towards the project for preliminary engineering and construction. More than 1,000 people attended the grand opening ceremonies near downtown Los Angeles.
