Zanja Madre Preservation

Construction on the retaining wall to preserve the exposed section of the Zanja Madre Aquaduct is complete. The Zanja appears to be in great condition with no damage resulting from landslides caused by recent rainstorms. Archeological crews will evaluate the physical condition and complete a final report and presentation for distribution. Our next steps include National Historic registration for the Zanja Madre.
