Congressional Staff Delegation Visits Los Angeles

A congressional staff delegation from Washington visited Los Angeles this week to participate in briefings and site visits focusing on transportation security issues in Los Angeles County. The trip highlighted current Metro Bus and Metro Rail security practices and identified funding and infrastructure needs. The delegation was also given briefings and tours of the City of Los Angeles ATSAC, the Los Angeles County Emergency Operations Center, the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach, and Los Angeles World Airport facilities.

Staff members from the offices of Reps. Xavier Becerra, Adam Schiff, Diane Watson and Henry Waxman, as well as Governor Schwarzenegger's Washington office, participated in this week's trip.

Metro to Test Effectiveness of Illuminated Bus Stop Signs

Metro is testing a solar-powered bus stop sign that provides illumination and can alert approaching operators that patrons are waiting. Metro Stops and Zones employees installed one "I-Stop Illuminated Transit Stop" in mid-May in Redondo Beach at the intersection of Artesia and Kingsdale near the South Bay Galleria. Another will be installed soon at a test site in Altadena. Areas that would benefit the most from illuminated bus stops would be the less populated, rural areas of the county and dimly lit stops and along Metro's overnight "owl service" bus lines. Currently, more than 90 transit agencies in such cities as London, Toronto, Chicago, Atlanta, London, Long Beach and OCTA, are using the I-Stop solar-powered equipment.
