Los Angeles City Council Transportation Committee Approves Draft Expo MCA

Earlier today, the Los Angeles City Council Transportation Committee approved the final draft Master Cooperative Agreement (MCA) between the Exposition Metro Line Construction Authority, Metro and the City. The MCA is on the Los Angeles City Council agenda for approval this Friday, July 14th. The MCA identifies the roles and responsibilities of each party in the design and construction of the Mid-City/Exposition Light Rail Transit Project. Metro staff had the opportunity to review the document and will be working with Expo and City staff tomorrow to discuss suggested changes that we would like incorporated into the document prior to its final adoption by the City Council.

Of Note

On this day in 1982, a newly-constructed Metro San Fernando Valley Division 15 opened in Sun Valley at the intersection of Glenoaks Boulevard and Branford Street to accommodate growing service demands. The original division, which opened on December 22, 1974, was located at Penrose Street and Tujunga Avenue.
