Summary Judgment for Metro in Fatal Collision Case

Last week, the Los Angeles Superior Court granted Metro's motion to dismiss all claims related to a bus/car intersection collision that occurred last year resulting in one fatality and injuries to three other people. Metro received a wrongful death claim and several indemnity claims. An appeal of this ruling is possible; however staff feels that it is unlikely.

The accident occurred on March 5, 2005 at the intersection of Grand Avenue and Venice Boulevard. At the time, the incident received media attention because of the involvement of a vehicle carrying four local teenagers who were returning from a car show at the Los Angeles Convention Center. The driver of the vehicle stated to police that she was not paying attention and ran a red light, resulting in the collision with a Metro bus.
