Metro to Host Chinese Public Works Audit Division Delegation

Metro will be hosting a delegation of 21 officials from the Public Works Audit Division of the People's Republic of China tomorrow, October 10th. The group includes the directors and deputy directors of audit bureaus for several of China's largest districts including Beijing, Xuanwu, Daxing, Yanqing, Changping, Miyun and Mentougou. The delegation is visiting the United States to learn about the process of public works auditing and audit planning, the development and implementation of quality control systems, and American audit procedures and methods. Metro staff will brief the international delegation on our agency's role in auditing Los Angeles County's transportation projects, the use of performance auditing, and the successful implementation of audit recommendations. The briefing will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the Malibu Conference Room on the 25th floor of the Gateway Headquarters building.

Go Metro to AIDS Walk Los Angeles
