### Media Invited to Attend Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension Tunneling Event

Media Relations distributed an advisory today inviting the news media to attend tomorrow's press event commemorating the successful completion of one of two tunnels for the Eastside Extension of the Metro Gold Line. The event is scheduled to begin at 10:30 a.m. at the intersection of First and Lorena Streets in Boyle Heights.

Earlier today, I was interviewed by the Associate Editor of *Progressive Railroading Magazine* today for an upcoming story for the magazine's Annual Industry Outlook issue scheduled to be released in December.
