Metro In Overdrive: Transportation Library & Archive Resources Featured In New Getty Museum Exhibit

The Metro Transportation Library & Archive is participating in a landmark joint exhibit of the Getty Museum and Getty Research Institute. Overdrive: L.A. Constructs The Future, 1940-1990 which runs from April 9 through July 21, 2013. Overdrive is part of Pacific Standard Time Presents: Modern Architecture In L.A. The exhibit is the first major exhibition to survey Los Angeles' complex urban landscape and diverse architectural innovations. Drawings, photographs, models, films, animations, oral histories and ephemera illustrate the complex dimensions of L.A.'s rich and often underappreciated built environment. Staff members attended a press and exhibitor reception Monday morning, featuring remarks by Los Angeles Mayor and Metro Board Director Antonio Villaraigosa. Library & Archive staff has been working with the Getty for one year in preparation for this exhibit.
