Twenty electric vehicle (EV) chargers at four Metro Park and Ride locations and Union Station are now fully open. This pilot effort is funded through a grant from the California Energy Commission. The electric vehicle chargers could be found at Union Station, Sierra Madre Villa, Universal City/Studio City, El Segundo, and Willow Street stations. This configuration allows EV owners to strategically plan their trip using a combination of EV and transit, particularly rail, to reach their destinations.
