Tomorrow, turnstiles at the Purple Line Wilshire/Normandie Station will be latched from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m in order to test for operational readiness, particularly for the new TAP Hands Free Gate Help device which will be stationed between the gates and ticket vending machines. Patrons who experience problems at the turnstiles can use Gate Help to get immediate assistance directly from Metro Rail Operations. Gate Help allows Rail Operations to monitor situations and unlatch turnstiles remotely if necessary. Metro attendants will be on hand to help patrons, and the station will be monitored to assess issues that will need to be addressed in preparation for latching all the gates later this year.
