Two new Metro Rapid lines – Pasadena-Hollywood and Hawthorne Boulevard – debut in December.

Metro Rapid Expands To Eleven Lines; Pasadena To Hollywood, South Bay To Downtown Added

The growing network of fast and frequent Metro Rapids is expanding to eleven lines with the addition of Hollywood-Pasadena and Hawthorne Boulevard routes.

New Metro Rapid Line 780 route runs along Hollywood, Los Feliz and Colorado boulevards between Hollywood and Pasadena.

New Metro Rapid Line 740 route runs between the South Bay Galleria and Downtown Los Angeles along Hawthorne Boulevard, Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and Broadway. [MN](#)

For Rose Parade Viewing, Metro Gold Line Eases The Way

Join those who discovered the easiest way to get to Pasadena's Annual Tournament of Roses – Metro Rail.

More than 26,000 parade viewers avoided the traffic and parking hassles last New Year's Day by using the fast and convenient Metro Gold Line. The Memorial Park, Del Mar, Lake and Allen stations are all just a short walk from the parade route.

The Gold Line will run overnight New Year's Eve through New Year's Day, with trains running as often as every 8 minutes beginning at 6 am.

A special shuttle will also be running from the Sierra Madre Villa Station to the float viewing area in Victory Park following the parade. The shuttle will run from 1 pm to 5 pm New Year's Day and from 7 am to 5 pm on Sunday, January 2. See metro.net for travel connections. **MN**

More Buses, More Often Starting December 19

Metro's local service sectors have been working overtime, the result being increased service on more than 70 Metro Bus lines starting December 19.

Most major routes throughout the Southland will benefit, with more buses running more often.

Increased service on 12 lines are on tap in the Metro San Gabriel Valley Service Sector; additional service on more than 24 lines is occurring in the Metro South Bay Service Sector; 15 lines get a service boost in the Metro Gateway Cities Service Sector; the Metro San Fernando Valley Service Sector added service on some 15 lines; 23 lines get service improvements in the Metro Westside/Central Service Sector.
