People Want Monorail, Survey Says

If the Los Angeles area gets a rapid transit system, residents here overwhelmingly prefer that it be a monorail, a survey disclosed Wednesday,

Facts Consolidated, an independent research organization, said the survey showed a 58.2% preference for monorail over other types of systems.

Second preference, among individuals questioned, went to a surface system, which received a 12.9% rating. Subways were favored by 10.7% and an elevated system by 8.2%. The remaining 10% said they favored none of the four systems.
