Council to Hear New Rapid Transit Proposal

ANAHEIM - Another proposed rapid transit system for this city will be outlined for City Council Tuesday, Dec. 19, at 10 a.m. in the Anaheim Convention Center.

The presentation will be made by Universal Design Limited of Miami, Fla., in conjunction with Anacal Engineering Co. of Anaheim.

It will be a monorail concept, according to Jeff Lodder of Anacal.

Another concept, the Dashavevor Mass Rapid Transit System, was explained to councilman Dec. 5. Its rubber-tired cars operate on twin rails.

Anaheim Rapid Transit System, Inc., seeks a 40year nonexclusive franchise to establish a circuit linking Anaheim and Buena Park entertainment and commercial centers.

The council has called for modifications in the proposed franchise agreement. Action on the amended agreement is expected Tuesday.

M. G. Jenkins of Fullerton, secretary of ARTS. says the 16-to-18-mile system probably would cost \$40 million.

He stressed ARTS will require two years to complete engineering and feasibility studies after a franchise is awarded.

Dashaveyor and Universal Design Limited are two of several concepts under consideration, Jenkins said.
