

- 4—From Whittier and Intermediate Points, change cars at Slauson Junction,

From Santa Ana and Intermediate Points, change cars at Watts

From Redondo Beach and Intermediate Points, change cars at Watts

to Newport Line or SPECIAL trains direct to Marine Stadium.

From San Pedro, use P. E. trains to Long Beach, then local street cars to Stadium.

From Long Beach, use local cars from P. E. Station to Stadium.

From Santa Monica (Bdy. Sta.) West Los Angeles, Beverly Hills, use Los Angeles Motor Coaches via Wilshire Blvd. to downtown Los Angeles. Then take P. E. trains at 6th & Main St. Station.

MOTOR TRANSIT SERVICE:

- 5—From San Bernardino, Redlands, Riverside, Colton, Corona, Orange, Santa Ana, Westminster, Anaheim, Fullerton, Buena Park, La Habra, Norwalk, Whittier, Downey, Santa Fe Springs, Bellflower, etc.

Use Motor Transit Stages to Long Beach, then local street cars to Marine Stadium.

Olympic Yachting Course

Location: Pacific Ocean off Point Fermin, San Pedro.

- 1—From Los Angeles, 6th & Main St. Station.

Take Pacific Electric San Pedro via Dominguez Line trains from Main St. Station to San Pedro (Los Angeles Harbor), from which point take frequent local street car service to Point Fermin.

- 2—From Hollywood District.

Use Los Angeles Motor Coach Co. service from Hollywood Union Bus Depot at 1627 No. Cahuenga Ave. to San Pedro Pacific Electric Station, then local street car service to Point Fermin.

Or, use Hollywood Blvd. and Santa Monica Blvd. cars, and "SUNSET" motor coaches to downtown Los Angeles, then San Pedro via Dominguez Line trains from 6th & Main St. Station to San Pedro, and local service to Point Fermin.

- 3—From Communities East, North and West of Los Angeles.

Use Pacific Electric trains and Motor Transit stages to Los Angeles. Then take San Pedro via Dominguez Line Pacific Electric trains from 6th and Main St. Station to San Pedro Station, from which point use local street car service to Point Fermin.

- 4—From Whittier and Intermediate Points, change cars at Slauson Junction,

From Santa Ana and Intermediate Points, change cars at Watts,

From Redondo Beach and Intermediate Points, change cars at Watts,

to San Pedro via Dominguez Line trains to San Pedro, then local street cars to Point Fermin.

From Long Beach, use P. E. trains to San Pedro, then local service to Pt. Fermin.

From San Pedro, use local street cars to Point Fermin.

From Santa Monica (Bdy. Sta.) West Los Angeles, Beverly Hills, use L. A. Motor Coaches via Wilshire Blvd. to downtown Los Angeles, then take P. E. trains at 6th & Main St. Station.

MOTOR TRANSIT SERVICE:

- 5—From San Bernardino, Redlands, Riverside, Colton, Corona, Orange, Santa Ana, Westminster, Anaheim, Fullerton, Buena Park, La Habra, Norwalk, Whittier, Downey, Santa Fe Springs, Bellflower, etc.

Use Motor Transit Stages to Long Beach, then take Pacific Electric Long Beach-San Pedro Line cars to San Pedro, and then local street cars to Point Fermin.

Olympic Auditorium

Located at 18th and Grand Ave., Los Angeles.

- 1—From Downtown Los Angeles: to Auditorium.

Take Pacific Electric "Vineyard" cars southbound on Hill St. Get off at Venice Blvd. & Grand Ave., walk 2 blocks south to Auditorium. 5c Fare.

Or, take Los Angeles Ry. "J" cars west on 7th St. to Grand, south on Grand to Auditorium. 7c Fare.

Or, take Los Angeles Ry. "W", "9" and "10" cars south on Broadway, west on 11th, south on Grand to Auditorium. 7c Fare.

- 2—From Hollywood District: to Auditorium.

For Morning and Afternoon Events:

Take Pacific Electric "Vineyard" cars eastbound on Hollywood Blvd., get off at Venice Blvd. & Grand Ave., walk 2 blocks south to Auditorium. 10c Fare.

Or, take cars on Santa Monica Blvd. and transfer to "Vineyard" cars as above. 10c Fare.

For Evening Events:

Take Hollywood Blvd. and Santa Monica Blvd. cars to Subway Terminal, transfer to "Vineyard" cars southbound on Hill. Get off at Venice Blvd. and Grand Ave., walk 2 blocks south to Auditorium. 10c Fare.

For Day & Evening Events:

Take "SUNSET" Los Angeles Motor Coaches eastbound on Sunset Blvd. which operate thru to Pershing Square. Then use service outlined in Paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles to Auditorium."

- 3—From Santa Monica Bay District and communities to the west and southwest of Los Angeles.

Use Pacific Electric trains inbound to Los Angeles. Get off at Venice Blvd. and Grand Ave., walk 2 blocks south to Auditorium.

- 4—From Communities Southwest, South and Southeast of Los Angeles.

Use Pacific Electric trains and Motor Transit stages inbound to Los Angeles, then use service to Auditorium as outlined in Paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles."

- 5—From San Fernando Valley Points, Glendale and Burbank.

Use Pacific Electric trains inbound to Los Angeles,

Subway Terminal. Then use service to Auditorium as outlined in Paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles."

- 6—From All Cities North and East of Los Angeles.

Use Pacific Electric trains and Motor Transit stages inbound to Los Angeles. Then use service outlined in Paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles."

Rose Bowl

Location: At Pasadena, in Arroyo Seco near Brookside Park, 1½ miles north of Colorado Blvd. Bridge.

- 1—From All Communities Southeast, South, Southwest, West and Northwest of Los Angeles: Use Pacific Electric trains and Motor Transit Stages to Los Angeles. Then use Pasadena Short Line and Oak Knoll Line trains from 6th & Main St. Sta. to Pasadena, changing at Colorado & Fair Oaks or Colorado & Raymond to LINCOLN AVENUE CARS, get off at Seco Street, walk west to Bowl entrance.

- 2—From San Bernardino, Redlands, Riverside, Colton, Rialto, Fontana, Etiwanda, Upland, Claremont, Pomona, La Verne, San Dimas, Covina, Baldwin Park, El Monte, Wilmar, etc.

Use Pacific Electric trains inbound to Los Angeles, get off at Valley Jct. and take Pasadena trains and local service in Pasadena as outlined in paragraph No. 1 above.

- 3—From Temple, San Gabriel, Alhambra, etc., change to Pasadena trains at Sierra Vista, then proceed as outlined in paragraph No. 1.

From Glendora, Azusa, Monrovia, Arcadia, etc., change to Pasadena trains at Oneonta or El Molino, then proceed as outlined in paragraph No. 1.

From Sierra Madre, change to Lincoln Ave. cars at Lamanda Park for Rose Bowl.

Riviera Country Club

Location: On Beverly Blvd. near Brentwood.

and

Olympic Cycle Road Course

Location: On Roosevelt Highway at North Santa Monica (Castellammare).

Reached from Downtown Los Angeles via Pacific Electric Beverly Blvd. Motor Coaches which leave from Pershing Square, Hill St. Side. See P. E. time tables for motor coach schedule.

Passengers from outlying cities, use Pacific Electric trains and Motor Transit stages to Los Angeles, then take Beverly Blvd. Motor Coaches as above.

Olympic Rifle Range

Location: In Elysian Park.


No public conveyances. Reached by private automobile only.

HOW TO GET THERE

Olympic Stadium

Olympic Swimming Stadium

Olympic Park Armory

1—From Downtown Los Angeles

Take Los Angeles Railway "U" cars west on Fifth St., south on Figueroa. Get off at 39th and Vermont.

Or, "9" cars South on Broadway—to Hoover and Santa Barbara Entrance.

Or, "10" cars South on Broadway—to Menlo and Santa Barbara Entrance.

Or, "F" cars South on Main from 3rd—to Hoover and Santa Barbara Entrance.

Or, "J" cars West on 7th, South on Grand to Jefferson and Figueroa or University.

Or, "Figueroa" Motor Coach from Pershing Square south on Hill to 8th, west on 8th to Hope, south on Hope to Washington, west on Washington to Figueroa, south on Figueroa to Figueroa Entrance.

Or, "Olympic Village" Motor Coach from Pershing Square, same route as "Figueroa" Coach.

7c fare on Los Angeles Railway Street cars—10c fare via Motor Coaches to Olympic Stadium.

2—From Hollywood District

Take "Sunset" Los Angeles Motor Coach eastbound on Sunset Blvd. and south on Vermont to Monroe transfer at that point to L. A. Ry. "V" cars south on Vermont to 39th Street Entrance.

Or, take Pacific Electric Hollywood Blvd. and Santa Monica Blvd. eastbound cars to Subway Terminal, then follow service outlined in paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles."

3—From Santa Monica Bay District and Communities West and Southwest of Los Angeles, including Venice, Ocean Park, Santa Monica, West Los Angeles, Beverly Hills, Culver City, Redondo Beach, Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach and Playa del Rey.

Use Pacific Electric inbound service, get off at Venice Blvd. and Vermont Ave. and take L. A. Ry. "V" cars southbound on Vermont to 39th Street Entrance.

Or, from Santa Monica, take Los Angeles Motor Coach at Broadway Station which operates via Wilshire; get off at Wilshire and Vermont and take L. A. Ry. "V" cars southbound on Vermont to 39th Street Entrance.

Or, continue thru to Pershing Square, then use service outlined in Paragraph No. 1, "From Downtown Los Angeles."

4—From Communities Southwest, South and Southeast of Los Angeles, including Redondo Beach, Gardena, Hawthorne, Torrance, San Pedro, Wilmington, Compton, Watts, Long Beach, Seal Beach, Sunset Beach, Huntington Beach, Newport Beach, Balboa, Santa Ana, Garden Grove, Artesia, Bellflower, Lyn-

wood, Whittier, Santa Fe Springs, Rivera, Bell, Maywood and Huntington Park.

Use Pacific Electric inbound trains to Long Beach Ave. and Vernon Ave. and take L. A. Ry. "V" car westbound on Vernon to Vermont, then north on Vermont to 39th Street Entrance.

Or, continue to Main Street Station, Los Angeles, and then use local service as outlined in paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles."

5—From Glendale and Burbank, San Fernando Valley Cities.

Use Pacific Electric trains to Subway Terminal, then service outlined in paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles."

6—From Sunland, Tujunga, La Crescenta, Verdugo City, Montrose and Glendale.

Use Motor Transit Stages to 5th and Los Angeles Stage Depot, then service outlined in paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles."

7—From Altadena, Pasadena, South Pasadena, Sierra Vista, Sierra Madre, Lamanda Park, San Marino, El Molino, Temple City, San Gabriel, Alhambra, etc.

Also, from Redlands, San Bernardino, Colton, Riverside, Rialto, Fontana, Etiwanda, Alta Loma, Ontario, Upland, Claremont, Pomona, La Verne, San Dimas, Covina, Baldwin Park, El Monte, Wilmar.

Use Pacific Electric service to Main Street Station, Los Angeles, then service outlined in paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles."

8—From Corona, Arlington, Riverside, San Jacinto Mountain and San Bernardino Mountain Points, Redlands, San Bernardino, Colton, Bloomington, Ontario, Pomona, Chino, and Intermediate Points: Also from Laguna Beach, Corona Del Mar, Santa Ana, Orange, Anaheim, Fullerton, Buena Park, Norwalk, Downey, La Habra, Whittier, Pico, Montebello, Belvedere Gardens.

Use MOTOR TRANSIT STAGES to 5th and Los Angeles Stage Depot, then service outlined in paragraph No. 1 "From Downtown Los Angeles."

Olympic Marine Stadium

Location: Long Beach, near Recreation Park.

1—From Los Angeles, Sixth & Main St. Station.

Take Newport Beach-Balboa-Huntington Beach Line trains or SPECIAL TRAINS direct to Marine Stadium.

2—From Hollywood District.

Use Los Angeles Motor Coach Co. service from Hollywood Union Bus Depot at 1627 N. Cahuenga Ave. to Long Beach, then local street car service to Marine Stadium.

Or, use Hollywood Blvd. and Santa Monica Blvd. cars, and "SUNSET" motor coaches to downtown Los Angeles, then Pacific Electric train service from 6th & Main St. Station direct to Marine Stadium.

3—From Communities East, North and West of Los Angeles.

Use Pacific Electric trains and Motor Transit stages to Los Angeles. Then take P. E. trains from 6th & Main St. Station direct to Marine Stadium.
