**FOSSILS FOUND IN SUBWAY TUNNEL** -- Paleontologist Dr. Bruce Lander explains to James Sowell, manager of environmental compliance for the Rail Construction Corporation (RCC), the finer points of Ice Age bones. The fossils -- identified as the remains of a horse, mastodon, bison and camel from the Pleistocene period -- were recovered recently during excavation of a Metro Red Line tunnel beneath Hollywood Boulevard in Los Angeles. The bones will be donated to area museums for scientific evaluation and preservation.
