MTA TO HOLD TWO PUBLIC WORKSHOPS IN SOUTH CENTRAL, SOUTHEAST AREA TO GATHER INPUT ON BICYCLE MASTER PLAN

Bicycle planning issues will be the key focus of two public workshops to be held Wednesday, April 26, by the MTA to gather comments and ideas from bicyclists in the South Central Los Angeles area and the Southeast area of Los Angeles County area to help the agency formulate a Bicycle Master Plan.

MTA staff will discuss existing bicycle routes and how to improve them, where new routes should be planned, safety issues, bicycle commuting, use of rail corridors for bikeways and other bicycle-related topics.
