MTA VOLUNTEERS JOIN HIGHLAND PARK COMMUNITY CLEANUP

WHAT: MTA volunteers will join a community cleanup in Highland Park sponsored by Congressman Xavier Becerra. MTA employees regularly volunteer in community efforts to eliminate graffiti and clear trash from public areas. In addition, work crews, made up of people referred by the L.A. County courts to do community service through MTA programs, will join the effort. The Highland Park cleanup will target major streets surrounding the Metro Blue Line Right-of-Way, including Figueroa Street, York Boulevard, and Marmion Way.

MTA will distribute fruit trees free to the first 100 volunteers to sign up.
