Matsumoto will be responsible for Finance, Administration, Employee and Labor Relations, Procurement and Transit Police. He also will remain the Authority's chief financial officer and will continue to focus on expanding the MTA's investor relations outreach program.

"Terry has a solid financial background and will provide a steady hand as we implement programs to improve the administration of the Authority, focus on our need to communicate well with the financial community and launch a centralized procurement function," Bohlinger said.
