MTA WORK CREW TAKES TO THE STREETS AS PART OF THE AUTHORITY'S NEW BUS STOP CLEANING PROGRAM

WHAT: MTA will deploy another 6-person crew as part of its Bus Stop Cleaning Program. The crew will clean one of the 18,000 Metro bus stops in Los Angeles County used by MTA passengers. Although historically this has not been MTA's responsibility, the Authority is undertaking this ambitious year-round project in an effort to create a pleasing environment for its 1-million daily riders. The owner of a business at the stop has agreed to assume responsibility for future cleanup of the stop as part of the "Adopt A Stop" element of the program.
