Subject	June 26, 2005 Service Changes for Metro San Fernando Valley

On June 26, 2005, major route and schedule changes will be implemented on Metro San Fernando Valley Lines 154, 161, 168, 243, 245, 418, 426 and 645. These changes are intended to produce more efficient schedules, to reallocate service hours for headway improvements, and to provide service hours for Metro Orange Line operation.

Service changes on Lines 156 and 233 will be implemented later this year with the startup of Metro Orange Line service. These changes will be implemented concurrently because service levels cannot be reduced along the Burbank/Chandler corridor until the Metro Orange Line is operational and providing replacement service. Please see attachment for a complete summary of June 2005 service changes.

Until the Metro Orange Line is implemented, current levels of service will be maintained on Lines 750 (Ventura Blvd.) and 165 (Victory Blvd.). After the Orange Line is operational, a nominal service reduction/reallocation will be made to reflect passengers migrating from lines 750 and 165 to the Metro Orange Line.
