## SUBJECT: COUNTYWIDE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT PROCUREMENT BENCH

## ACTION: INCREASE THE CUMULATIVE TOTAL AUTHORIZED AMOUNT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

# **RECOMMENDATION**

Increase the cumulative total value amount by \$6 million for the Countywide Planning and Development Bench under Contract Number PS-4310-1268 to provide planning related services on smaller scale planning, architectural and engineering, and non-architectural and engineering projects increasing the total authorized not-to-exceed amount from \$6 million to \$12 million.

#### **ISSUE**

On July 2003, the Metro Board approved a Countywide Planning and Development (CP&D) Procurement Bench to award task orders for a five (5) year period beginning on August 1, 2003 for professional services not to exceed a cumulative total value amount of \$6 million. The \$6 million cumulative total value amount was initially set as a limit for the work contracted through the Planning Bench. The Planning Bench firms are listed as part of the Procurement Summary (Attachment A). Attachment B itemize the task orders that were awarded to date and the task orders in process but not yet awarded in the CP&D department, which total \$5.3 million since the bench was established. It is anticipated that CP&D's FY06 work plan may exceed the total authorized amount before the fiscal year ends. Based on the past performance of the Bench and effectiveness of the program in fast tracking our contracts, the cumulative total value amount should now be amended.

# POLICY IMPLICATIONS

The Planning Bench helps Metro to deliver its planned projects and programs more efficiently.

# **ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED**

The Board could choose not to approve this recommendation; however, award of these task orders would then be pursued as a separate procurement and subjected to an acquisition cycle of potentially up to six (6) months. This alternative is not recommended because many of these task orders are integral parts of or complimentary work to larger projects, which requires them to be completed within the schedule constraints of the larger projects. Also, project costs continue to increase every year as project funding becomes more limited; therefore, Metro needs to continue to be innovative with its administrative processes in order to meet the mobility needs of the people of Los Angeles in a timely yet cost effective manner.

# FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of this recommendation would not result in any financial impacts to the Metro's FY06 budget. Bench contracts/task orders are funded through the regular Metro budget process.

# **DISCUSSION**

The Planning Bench allows staff to award projects in a short period of time since most of the acquisition process and qualification reviews were already completed in advance. The Bench includes 55 firms in 17 disciplines including transportation planning, engineering, architectural, financial analysis services and others. Task orders are issued competitively in response to Requests for Proposals. The base contract will end on July 30, 2006. At that time, CP&D plans to exercise its options to continue awarding task orders that may carryover to FY07 as well as new work. The Bench has been a success in awarding contracts in a timely manner and is recommended to continue with this time saving process.

# NEXT STEPS

Once the cumulative total value amount is amended, task orders can continue to be awarded with no timing delays.

## B. Procurement Background

- All firms listed that have previously conducted work for MTA have performed satisfactorily.
- This Bench contract was initially approved by the Metro Board in July 2003 (Item No. 9) for a total cumulative amount not to exceed \$6 Million for a five year period, inclusive of two one year options. Task Orders are issued for each planning and development requirement. The Task Orders are competed only among those Bench contractors qualified for that discipline area.
- Each Architect and Engineering (A&E) Task Order requirement will be competed among Bench firms qualified for that skill set, and each of the qualified firms will be sent an RFP for that specific Task Order requirement. After submittal of the contractor's technical evaluation, the highest evaluated contractor will be requested to submit a complete Firm Fixed Price, MTA Form 60 cost proposal. The proposal must be compliant with the DBE/SBE goals set forth in the RFP.
- Each non Architect and Engineering (A&E) Task Order requirement will be competed among Bench firms qualified for that skill set, and each of the qualified firms will be sent an RFP for that specific Task Order requirement. A completed MTA Form 60 will be required with the Task Order proposal submittal. The Task Order award will be made competitively, to the proposal most advantageous to the MTA considering the technical merits and reasonability of price. The proposal must be compliant with the DBE/SBE goals set forth in the RFP.
- Each Bench contractor will have expertise in a minimum of one of the following disciplines:
  - 1. Transportation Planning
  - 2. Environmental Planning
  - 3. Environmental Engineering
  - 4. Traffic Engineering
  - 5. Civil/Transportation Engineering
  - 6. Land Surveying
  - 7. Structural Engineering
  - 8. Geotechnical and Soil Engineering
  - 9. Electrical Engineering
  - 10. Mechanical Engineering
  - 11. Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Planning and Engineering
  - 12. Architectural/Urban Design
  - 13. Landscape Architecture
  - 14. Database Technical Services
  - 15. Economic Analysis
  - 16. Financial Analysis
  - 17. Geographic Information System

- Price fairness and reasonableness determination will be made for each Task Order at the time of release.
- The Diversity and Economic Opportunity Department (DEOD) will determine a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) contract-specific participation goal upon review of each task order issued for the Planning, Architectural, and Engineering Services Bench project. Proposers were requested to form teams that include a sufficient number of DBE firms to perform the scopes of work identified in the solicitation document.

## C. Evaluation of Proposals

- Competitive qualification statements were sought and reviewed by a Source Selection committee. They were evaluated for qualifications and technical competency to perform the required work in the specific disciplines proposed.
- The RFIQ contained neither price nor a specific Statement of Work. Each future contract/Task Order will contain a specific Statement of Work, which will be sent to all Bench consultants qualified in that specific survey area. The Bench consultants will propose according to the requirements of the RFP.
- Placement on the Bench will not guarantee an award of any Task Order.
