SUBJECT: IN-TRAIN CCTV-CARBORNE DVR SYSTEM

ACTION: APPROVE CONTRACT MODIFICATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$800,000 TO AJK COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate and execute Contract Modification No. 1 to Contract No. OP 3920-1633 with AJK Communications, Inc. to provide additional video cameras per car on the Metro Heavy Rail Vehicles (HRVs) and Metro Light Rail Vehicles (LRVs) in an amount not to exceed \$800,000 increasing the Total Contract Value from \$2,187,019 to \$2,987,019.

RATIONALE

Metro presently has 104 HRVs operating on the Metro Red Line subway system and 121 LRVs on the Metro Blue, Green and Gold Lines. The In-Train CCTV – Carborne DVR System (System) is used to provide real-time security monitoring, and graffiti and incident recording in the interior of the existing fleet of Metro rail vehicles. This System will function both as a deterrent and a real-time record of any illegal or potentially harmful acts that may be used as evidence in any forensic investigation or subsequent legal action. The System will have the capability to store video and event data, and ensure prompt retrieval of saved information at any time.

During installation of the planned system, staff discovered that additional cameras would be necessary to provide the required video coverage of the passenger areas and looking forward from the operator's cab. Contract Modification No. 1 provides for 346 cameras, 104 for the Metro Red Line HRVs and 242 for the Metro Blue, Green, and Gold Line LRVs, their installation and all of the associated domes, mountings, and wiring necessary to operate in the system. Since the HRV installation is partially funded by a federal Homeland Security Grant, the installation of the additional cameras proceeded prior to the expiration of the Grant.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funding for this action is included in the FY06 Budget in Project 200018 Homeland Security, Cost Center 2610 and Project 205004 Rail Security Improvement, Cost Center 3960. This action does not impact the authorized Life-of-Project for either Capital Project.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

An alternative is not to install the additional cameras into the In-Train CCTV – Carborne DVR System on the existing HRVs. This alternative was not considered since this system is part of the comprehensive safety and security plan to improve Metro's monitoring systems, which the Board approved in July 2005.

A. <u>Background on Contractor</u>

AJK Communications, Inc. (AJK or Contractor) is an Orange County, Californiabased certified DBE company. AJK provides multiple products and services to the Military & Defense, Industrial, Transportation, Security and Communications markets. AJK's expertise includes designing and integration of communication systems including the education and training of client staff. They utilize local professional installers of fiber optics, copper cable systems and support hardware. AJK also provides Project Management, Materials & Contracts Management consulting services.

B. Procurement Background

During the August 2005 Board meeting the Board awarded Contract Op 3920-1633 for the In-Train CCTV and Carborne DVR System (System) to AJK Communications, Inc. in response to staff recommendation based upon an <u>Expedited</u> Two-Step, Technically-Acceptable, Low-Bid process.

During The installation of the System, it was discovered that the original number of cameras required by Metro would not be sufficient to provide the needed video coverage of the passenger areas and of the needed coverage looking forward from the operator's cab. Because of the time constraints of both the Board's expressed policy regarding this system and the federal Homeland Security Grant for the HRV system, the Contractor proceeded with the purchase and installation of the additional video cameras and the related ancillary hardware for these Metro Red Line subway vehicles.

Modification No. 1 is currently in negotiations is for those additional cameras, domed housings, wiring, and their installation.
