

Roger Chandler has been elected to three terms on the Arcadia City Council and this is his third term as Mayor. Mr. Chandler has consistently demonstrated a commitment to ensuring the public receives outstanding public service. Among his priorities are maintaining an excellent public safety program, the provision of effective and efficient municipal services, and the development of a regional public transportation system that meets the needs of tri-city residents (Arcadia, El Monte and Temple City). Sufficient levels of bus and rail transit, a safe and sound infrastructure, and ensuring that there are minimal negative impacts from the construction of the Gold Line Rail System are all important issues on which Mr. Chandler will work diligently to bring to fruition.

Mr. Chandler has dedicated much of his life to public service. At 21 years of age, he joined the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and was with that organization for 24 years. After retiring from the Sheriff's Department, he went on to become the Chief of Police of the Los Angeles City Housing Authority, and in 1994, created the City of Hawaiian Gardens Police Department.

Mr. Chandler holds a Master's Degree in Public Administration from the University of Southern California. Roger and his wife Jane have lived in Arcadia for over 28 years and they have two sons.
