Recommendations

- A. Approve \$48,147,200 contribution to SCRRA FY 2007-08 Budget
- B. Approve the reprogramming of \$4,898,900 in unused FY 2005-06 subsidy
- C. Approve a two-year time extension for the Eastern Maintenance Facility Project



Cost Savings

- September 2006 Board action to approve new formula for allocating Metrolink's operating costs
- \$1 million savings to LACMTA projected
- Savings of \$1.65 million now estimated due to the new formula



New Service Proposed

- New Sunday Service on Antelope Valley Line proposed for start-up in September, 2007
- Additional Sunday service on San Bernardino Line and Saturday service on Antelope Valley Line also proposed
- Cost of proposed service more than offset by cost savings from new formula

Cost/Benefit Study

- As part of September 2006 Board action to approve formula, staff directed to conduct cost/benefit study of Metrolink
- HNTB Consultants currently performing cost/benefit analysis
- Depending on the results of the study, staff may return to the other SCRRA member agencies to further modify formula



Time Extension

- Eastern Maintenance Facility \$7.9 million originally funded through 2001 Call for Projects
- Project delayed due to negotiations with BNSF Railroad regarding land acquisition
- Easement to be signed by July, 2007
- Facility needed to house trains now on order and ease capacity at Taylor Yard



Next Steps

- Staff will return to the Board with results of the cost/benefit study
- Staff will also return with report on Metrolink's capital needs, which are no longer funded through the Call for Projects
