

Elements of Sustainable Implementation





Greenhouse Gas Reduction Efforts

- Continued discussions with California Climate Registry
- Participated in APTA Conference Calls
 - Goal is to develop multi-agency protocol for subtracting vehicle miles traveled (VMT) prior to registering emissions footprint
 - Completion of protocol is critical prior to registering
- Coordination meeting with Metro Clean Air Task Force
- Continued to gather Greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions records and started calculations
- Interagency coordination and sharing
 - Staff attended October 2007 L.A. City Council Sustainability briefings
 - Learn other agency best practices regarding climate change registration and GHG reductions



Status of Recent Energy and Efficiency Projects

 Division 9 is open for business as of October 2007

LEED Silver (Metro's first)



 All panels installed and inverter installation in progress. Will be complete late-November 2007.





Recently Completed Energy and Efficiency Projects

- RRC Solar and Energy Conservation **Project**
 - 1 megawatt of Solar panels
 - Replace lighting, HVAC, compression
 - Partnership with LADWP, Gas Company and AQMD
 - Negotiations ongoing, scheduled for January 2008 Board
- Escalator Motor Controllers
 - Facilities has completed 120 of 122 escalators and project will complete November 2007
 - Controllers save 35% less electricity








Environmental Management System

- Metro received FTA's acknowledgement letter for EMS Training and Assistance Grant Application
 - EMS training to be conducted by Shaw Environmental (Seattle, WA)
 - Interviews: Fall 2007
 - Notice and implementation: Spring 2008
- EMS Pilot Study discussions with consultant


Evolution of Environmental Management


