AWARD MULTIPLE AWARDS AGREEMENT ACTION:

#### RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to:

A. Award a seven-year fixed price, unit-rate multiple awards agreement to provide workers' compensation investigation services in an amount not to exceed \$4,153,807, inclusive of four one-year options, effective October 1, 2008, with the following firms:

C. Issue task orders under this agreement in amount not to exceed \$4,153,807.

#### **RATIONALE**

These actions establish a panel of firms that will provide investigation services for Risk Management's Special Investigations Unit beginning October 1, 2008. The panel will provide investigative resources on an "as needed" basis in support of our workers' compensation program and courtesy investigations from time to time. Approval of the five qualified alternate firms will allow us to be able to replace or add qualified firms without redoing a procurement process and ensures a panel of sufficient size to meet our needs.

#### **Background**

## Workers' Compensation Program

We have an aggressive and effective workers' compensation fraud deterrence, detection and prosecution program. Each of these elements has been instrumental in deterring fraud and containing our overall workers' compensation costs. A panel of highly qualified investigation firms who are diverse in experience, technical expertise, ethnicity and geographic location are vital to our ability to continue to tailor investigation resources to the workload and to be effective in keeping our costs down.

## **Courtesy Investigation Services**

The panel will also be utilized for courtesy investigations. Courtesy investigations are cases where individual departments require an investigation but have no resources to investigate or expertise in conducting investigations. These investigations are requested by managers throughout the agency for a variety of issues such as identifying and locating subrogation targets to recoup our losses, locating witnesses in Metro-involved traffic accidents or litigation cases, investigation of employee use of leave programs, investigation of illegal sale of fare media, and other issues, both criminal and administrative. Up to now all courtesy investigations have been conducted in-house by staff investigators. Requests for courtesy investigations have grown significantly. Therefore, staff resources will be supplemented by support from the panel to accommodate the increased workload.

### FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funding of \$551,955 for this service is included in FY09 budget in cost center number 0531, under project number 300004, RM - Workers' Compensation. Since this is a multi-year contract, the cost center manager and Chief Financial Services Officer and Treasurer will be accountable for budgeting the costs in future years, including any option exercised. In FY08, \$383,969 was expended on investigation costs.

#### **ALTERNATIVE CONSIDERED**

The option of bringing all investigation services in-house was considered. This alternative is not recommended because the level of investigative services required fluctuates significantly from week to week, our large service area, and the need for specialized vehicles and surveillance equipment. Use of the panel allows us to effectively task firms with the necessary manpower in the right geographic areas and who will provide the appropriate vehicles and equipment for the investigations at hand.

## A. Background on Contractor

RJN Investigations, Inc. of Riverside, California has been in business since 1992. Since that time, RJN Investigations has provided Workers' Compensation Investigation services for the City and County of San Francisco, the County of Riverside, Riverside Department of Corrections and Southern California State Fund.

Baechler Investigative Services of San Diego, California has been in business since May 1981 and has provided Workers' Compensation Investigation Services for such companies as Intercare Insurance Services and the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office.

Probe Information Services, Inc. was established in 1992. Their headquarters are in Sacramento, California, but they offer comprehensive services in at least 12 other states. They have provided Workers' Compensation Investigation services for the County of Sacramento, City of Palo Alto and other independent or private companies.

Benn & Associates of Orange, California was incorporated in California in May 1997. Since that time, Benn & Associates has provided Workers' Compensation Investigation Services to the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles, the County of San Bernardino and such companies as SBC/Pacific Telesis, The Stockman Group and others.

Fu-Gen, Inc of Beverly Hills, California has been in business since 1985. Mr. Burton has worked for RJN Investigations as an independent contractor, but was also on the Panel of Investigators for Avis Car Rental from 1994 to 1997. Additionally, Burton Investigations provided services to Compton City Attorney LeGrand H. Clegg.

Specialized Investigations of Northridge, California was established in 1981 as a special investigations unit by the parent company, Schifrin, Gagnon & Dickey, Inc. Their client list include insurance carriers such as Zurich North America, the Zenith, Travelers, as well as Hertz Claims Management and other self-insured companies, third party administrators, law firms, public entities, corporations, businesses and individuals.

Page Investigations of Moreno Valley, California was established in 1991. Since then, services have been provided to County San Bernardino Risk Management, and various attorneys in Workers' Compensation surveillance cases.

Stewart Investigative Services was started over 16 years ago in Riverside, California as a sole proprietor, and incorporated in 2001. Since then, the company has been providing insurance services to workers' compensation insurance carriers, third party administrators, self insured public entities and liability insurance companies. The company has been on the selected investigations panel for the County of San Bernardino, the County of Los Angeles as well as the Los Angeles Unified School District.

## B. Procurement Background

On April 7, 2008, a solicitation was issued to establish a Panel for Workers' Compensation Investigation services using the explicit factors evaluation methodology. This solicitation required award to the highest rated firms based on the combined technical criteria. The Source Selection committee reviewed the proposals and ranked the firms technically. Price was not a factor in this solicitation since the Special Investigations Unit (SIU) established the rates that will be used to compensate the contractors selected for the panel. The fifteen firms with the highest scoring were recommended for award.

Task Orders will be issued for each individual assignment. Task Orders will be assigned to contractors based on the following criteria in the listed order of importance:

- past performance on prior task order work,
- qualifications of the Contractor, and
- geographical considerations.

The Diversity & Economic Opportunity Dept. (DEOD) recommended a Disadvantaged Anticipated Level of Participation (DALP) of 25%. Five of the fifteen contractors recommended for award are DBE primes.

## C. Evaluation of Proposals

Thirty-one proposals were received and evaluated in accordance with our Procurement Policies and Procedures Manual. Five proposers did not meet the minimum

requirements and were not considered beyond the preliminary evaluation. The technical qualification of the remaining twenty-six proposers were evaluated and scored based on a review of the proposals, clarifications, and reference check information. The fifteen contractors recommended for award and the five alternates were selected based on the highest scores received and were determined to be the most advantageous when qualifications and other factors were considered. The remaining six proposals received the lowest scores and, therefore, were not considered for award or as alternates.

## D. Cost/Price Analysis Explanation of Variances

The recommended price has been determined to be fair and reasonable based upon a market analysis performed by the SIU Project Manager. Data was obtained from the current panel for Investigative Services, from Investigative Firms and from other Public Agencies in the determination of fair and equitable rates. All Contractors performing investigative services under these Contracts will be compensated utilizing the same, preestablished rates.
