
Eastside Gold Line Bus/Rail Interface

Connectivity (Meet trains at major terminals)	 Little Tokyo is the primary downtown access. Line 30/730 will provide distribution along Broadway. Dual Hub BRT will provide distribution in Bunker Hill. Various SGV changes to serve GL stations, particularly at Indiana and Atlantic/Pomona Stops. Connection to ELAC via existing services.
Duplication (Minimize duplication of rail service)	1) Reduce Line 30 service duplication along 1st from Alameda to Indiana.
Access (Maintain transit on street segments currently served)	1) Maintain service on Floral and 1st with extensions of existing lines.
Resources (Cost neutral or savings)	 Reduce service on 1st between Alameda and Indiana. Reduce service on Floral and 1st east of Indiana. Possible increase in N/S feeder service.






Line 30/31 & Gold Line Extension



Gold Line Interface – All Stations






Boyle Heights/East LA Route










Downtown Duplication (444, 446/447, 484, 490)










Downtown Routing Overview
