SUBJECT: STATUS OF PROJECTS BEING BUILT BY A CONSTRUCTION

AUTHORITY

ACTION: RECEIVE AND FILE

RECOMMENDATION

Receive and file the Status Report on Construction Authority Projects.

ISSUE

Staff has been instructed by the Board of Directors to provide monthly updates on the following projects being built by Construction Authorities: Alameda Corridor East Grade Separation; Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRRA) Eastern Maintenance Facility; and Exposition Light Rail Transit Project.

BACKGROUND

Attached are the updates on the projects as requested by the MTA Board. The Alameda Corridor East Project Phase I is progressing well as the Temple Avenue project in the City of Pomona and the Sunset Avenue grade separation project in the City of Industry are under construction and expected to be completed in October 2009 and December 2010, respectively. Project is within budget and on-schedule (Attachment A). The Metrolink Eastern Maintenance Facility is under construction as the transportation building, fuel pump house, utility building, service & inspection facility, and the train wash are all under construction. Project is within budget and anticipated to be completed 13 days behind the original schedule (Attachment B). With regards to the Expo Light Rail Transit Project, 16 of the 20 construction packages have been negotiated in an amount totaling \$382 million and the project is within budget. The contractor's baseline schedule anticipates a forty-four week delay in the project; however, Expo staff is working with the contractor to mitigate as much of the schedule as possible (Attachment C). For further schedule and costs information on the above projects, see respective Attachments.

NEXT STEPS

Staff will continue to monitor the above projects and will submit a Board Box Item for the month of August 2009.

MONTHLY PROJECT STATUS REPORT

Project: Eastern Maintenance Facility Month: May 2009

STATUS:

The transportation building is continuing with the installation of tile at the women's and men's locker room, the painting of interior rooms, the installation of acoustical ceiling; the building exterior is complete with the exception of the painting of the canopy. The fuel pump house is continuing with the installation of the fueling equipment and lines to the service and inspection facility. The utility building is continuing with the installation of the equipment piping for the sand distribution as well as the other equipment and piping for the compressed air. The service and inspection facility is continuing with the installation of the fueling lines/crane and electrical conduit work as well as the erection of the platforms. The train wash is continuing with the installation of the equipment in the train wash building as well as the equipment piping. Electrical work throughout the project site continues to progress with the installation of the transformers and equipment cabinets as well as wire pulling. The track work is continuing with track installation at the trainwash and the service & inspection facility. The Security and Supervisor booths have been mobilized on site and ready for installation.

MONTHLY PROJECT STATUS REPORT

Project: Expo Light Rail Transit Project

Month: <u>May 2009</u>

SCOPE: Phase 1 of the Exposition Light Rail Transit project is currently under construction. Phase 1 of the Project is approximately 8.6 miles long, extending from downtown Los Angeles to Culver City. Phase 1 will have 11 stations, which includes two existing stations shared with the Blue Line and nine new stations. Three of the new stations are aerial. Phase 2 of the Exposition Transit Corridor project from Culver City to Santa Monica is in the environmental phase.

ISSUES:

Cost Related

16 of 20 construction packages have been negotiated in an amount totaling \$382 million and currently under running the revised construction budget. The negotiated total amount includes approximately \$4.8 million in partially negotiated construction packages.

Schedule Related

The design-build contractor's April 2009 schedule update indicates substantial completion will occur in December 2010 forty-four weeks later than originally planned. The incorporation of the Culver City aerial station (approved by the Metro Board in April 2008) in lieu of the interim at-grade station will result in a delay to substantial completion. Authority has directed the contractor to mitigate as much of the schedule as possible. New revised completion date(s) are currently being discussed with the contractor.
