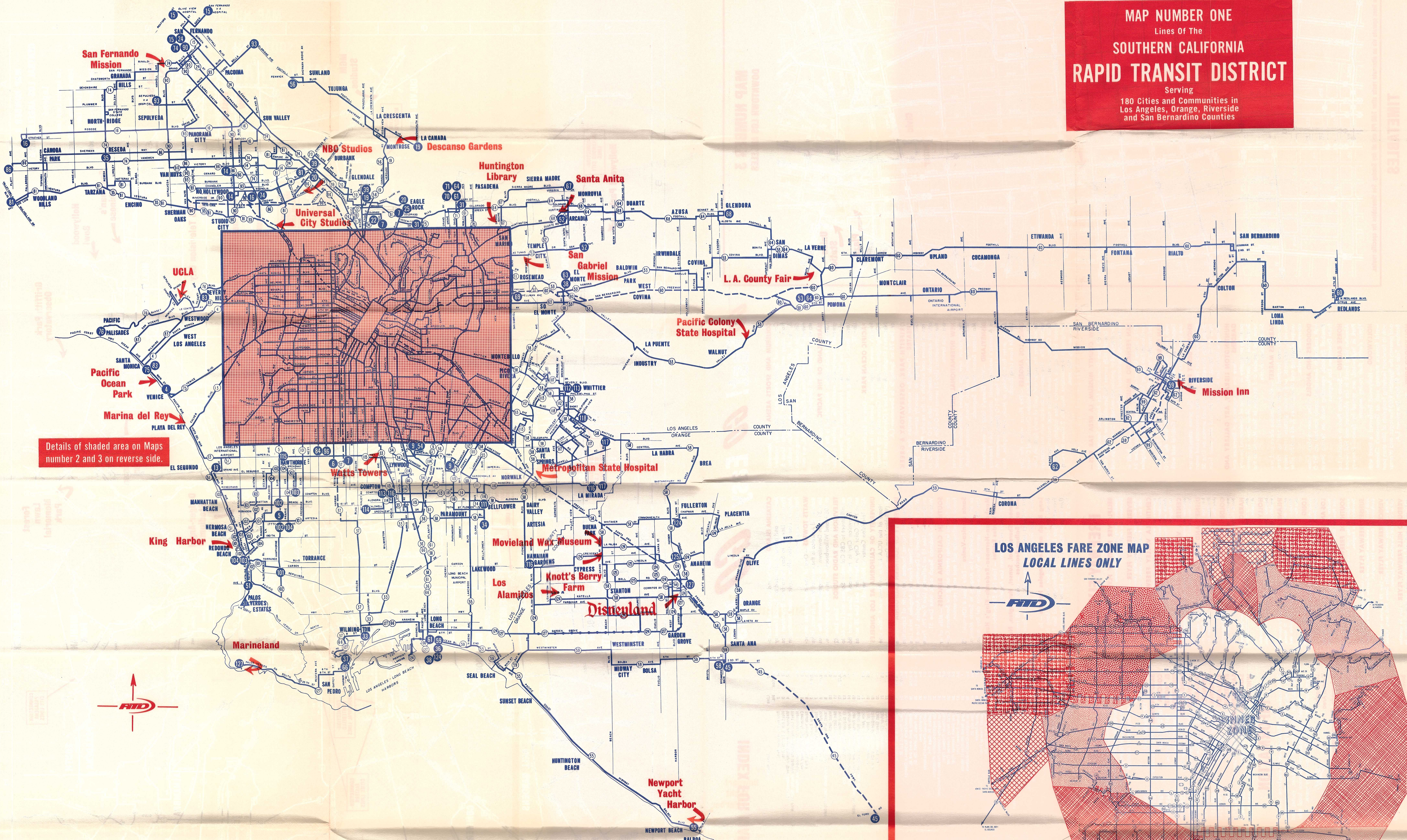


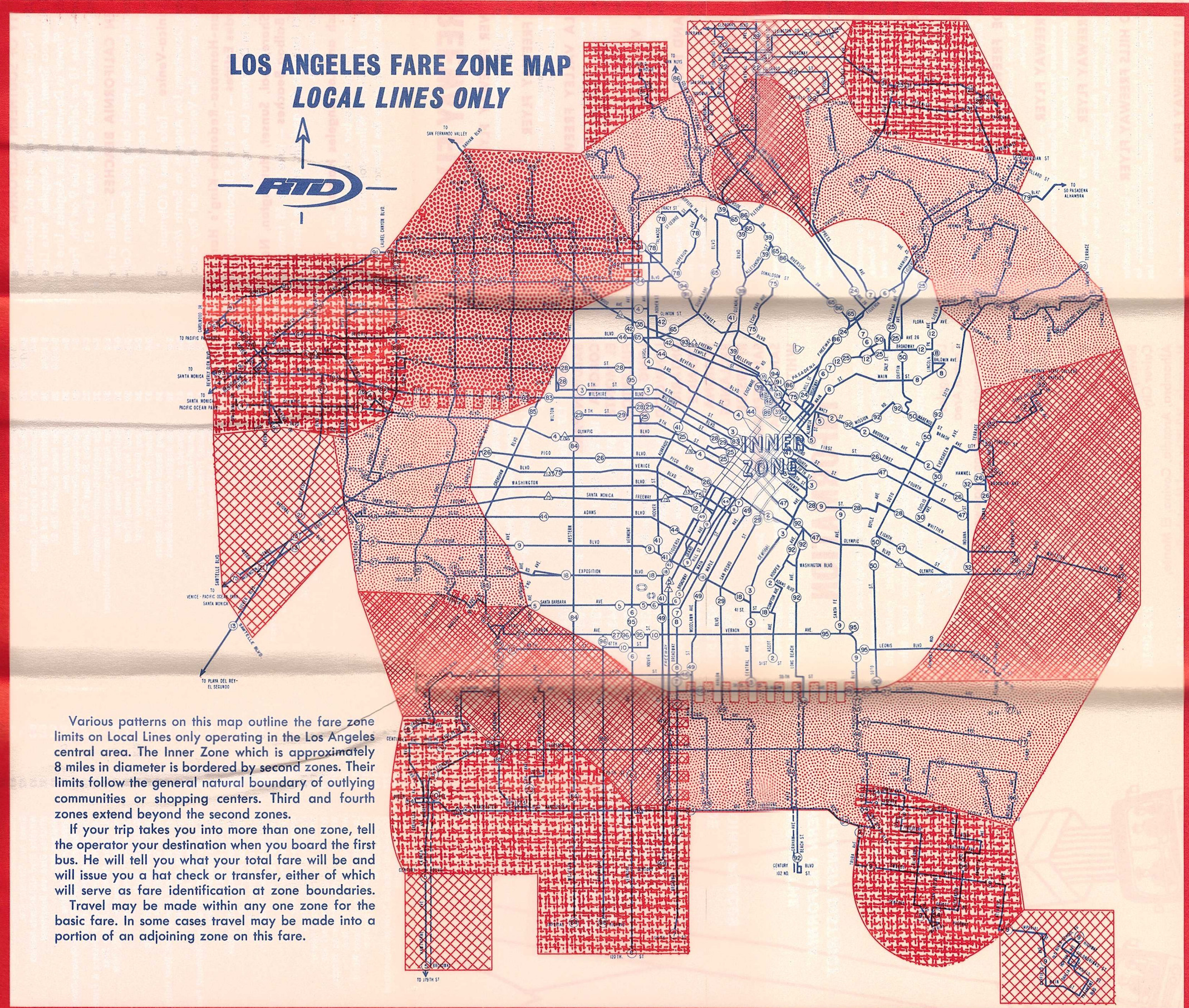
**MAP NUMBER ONE**

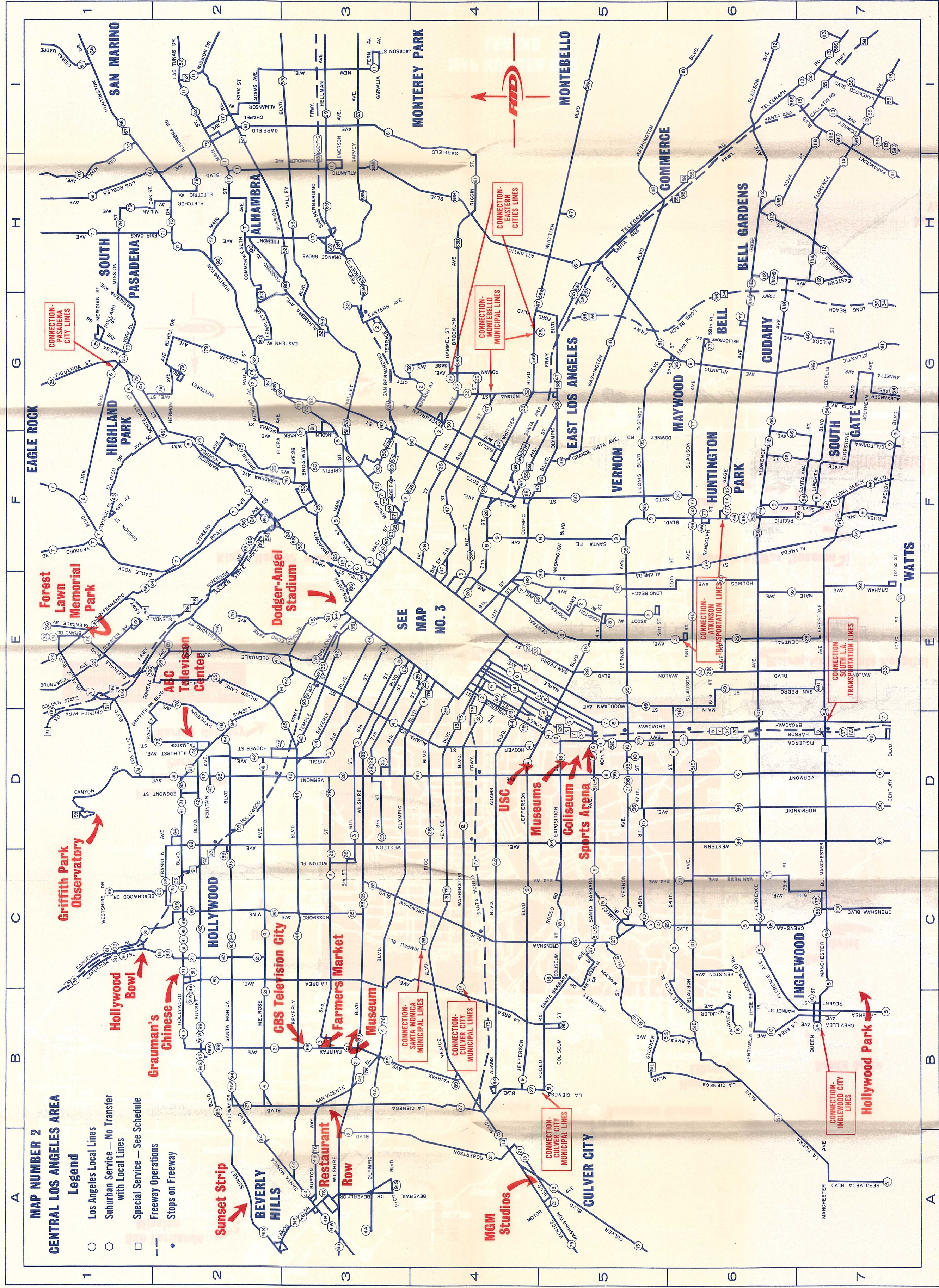

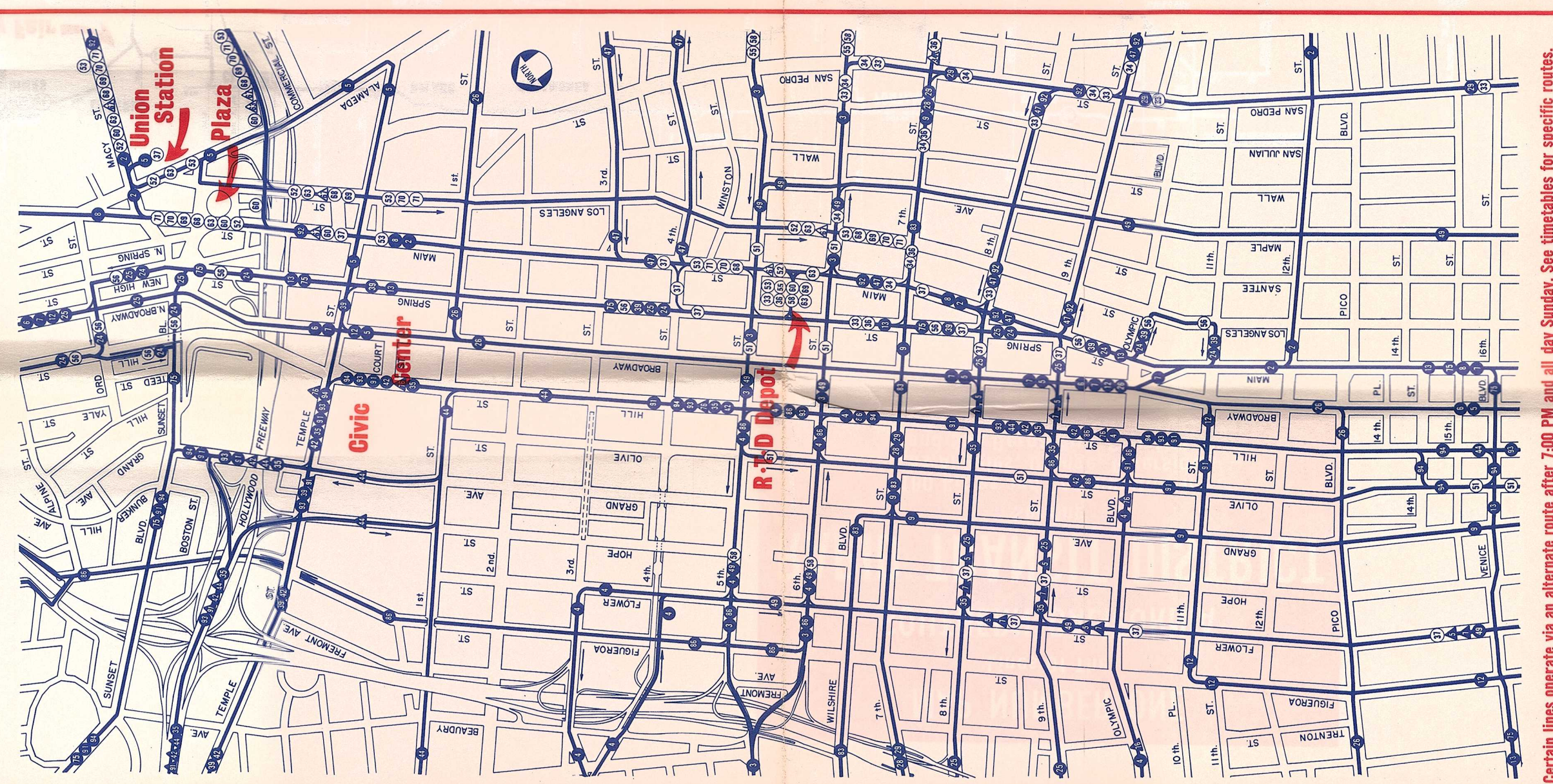
Various patterns on this map outline the fare zone limits on Local Lines only operating in the Los Angeles central area. The Inner Zone which is approximately 8 miles in diameter is bordered by second zones. Their limits follow the general natural boundary of outlying communities or shopping centers. Third and fourth zones extend beyond the second zones.

If your trip takes you into more than one zone, tell the operator your destination when you board the first bus. He will tell you what your total fare will be and will issue you a hat check or transfer, either of which will serve as fare identification at zone boundaries. Travel may be made within any one zone for the basic fare. In some cases travel may be made into a portion of an adjoining zone on this fare.

**Go Fast! Go Easy! GO Bus!**

**CATALINA ISLAND** — Year round service to the Catalina boats and planes is provided by Special Freeway Flyers on Line 5 to San Pedro from Downtown Los Angeles Park and Long Beach. All other service from Huntington Park and Long Beach.

**WATTS TOWERS** — One of the most unique attractions in all America is the unusual Watts Towers. Take Line 33 from Downtown Los Angeles leaving the bus at 108th and Willowbrook for an exciting experience.

**TELEVISION AND RADIO STUDIOS** — Take Line 42 on Hill Street to CBS Columbia Square and Line 44 to CBS Television City in Hollywood. Lines 81 and 86 serve NBC Color City in Burbank, and Line 78 serves ABC Television Center in Hollywood.

**UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA AT LOS ANGELES** — Home of the UCLA Bruins in Westwood. Take Line 88 (Withhite) from Downtown Los Angeles.

**UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA** — Home of the USC Trojans, located just north of Exposition Park. Take Line 10 from Downtown Los Angeles to Alvarado, Line 18 on Jefferson, Line 9 on 7th, from Westchester-Redondo Beach area, take Line 51.

**SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BEACHES** — Mile after mile, famous beaches stretch along the Southern California coastline for surf and sand recreation.

**Santa Monica-Venice** — Take Lines 4 (Olympic), 75 or 83 from Downtown Los Angeles to Santa Monica.

**Manhattan-Hermosa-Redondo-King of the Reef** — Pala Verde Estates — Take Line 51 southbound on Olive Street in Downtown Los Angeles.

**Balboa Beach, Seal, Sunset, Huntington, New-Balboa** — Take Line 55 from the R-T-D Depot, between 5th and 6th, enter on Spring or Main in Los Angeles.

**Long Beach and Los Angeles Harbors** — To Long Beach and Long Beach Harbor, take the Long Beach Freeway Flyer; Line 36; to Wilmington and San Pedro (Los Angeles Harbor) take the Harbor Freeway Flyer Line 37.

**GRIFFITH PARK, OBSERVATORY & GREEK THEATRE** — Take Line 5 from Downtown Los Angeles to Griffith Park, Observatory, and Greek Theatre. Additional service is provided during special events. Also located here, in Exposition Park, are outstanding Museums and Gardens.

**MARINELAND OF THE PACIFIC** — Located in picturesque Palos Verdes, Marineland is the world's greatest showplace of marine life. A limited number of trips on Line 127 serve Marineland from Downtown Los Angeles. Connecting service from Los Angeles on Line 37.

**PACIFIC OCEAN PARK** — One of Southern California's newest playgrounds is located at the beach. Take Line 127 from Downtown Los Angeles to Pacific Ocean Park. Also take Line 127 from Huntington Park and Long Beach.

**NEW COUNTY MUSEUM, LA BREA TAR PITS** — Line 83 from Downtown Los Angeles, Santa Monica or Beverly Hills serves this beautiful new Museum and burial ground of prehistoric animals. Smart shops and restaurants are located nearby.

**SAN FERNANDO MISSION** — This mission, built in 1818, is now in semi-restored condition. Take Line 24 northbound on Spring Street in Downtown Los Angeles and transfer to Line 90 in San Fernando.

**SAN GABRIEL MISSION** — Built in 1774. To visit this well preserved mission, take Line 52 from the R-T-D Depot, to Santa Anita Street in San Gabriel and walk one quarter mile south.

**KNOTT'S BERRY PARK** — The prime attractions are the famous most popular amusement park in the world. Take Line 58 from Downtown Los Angeles to Knott's Berry Park. Enter on Main, Los Angeles.

**HUNTINGTON LIBRARY, ART GALLERY AND GARDENS** — Here are masterpieces of literature and painting on display in a setting of landscaped beauty. Board Line 68 northbound on Main Street in Downtown Los Angeles and transfer in San Marino to the Sierra Madre shuttle.

**FARMERS MARKET** — World famous shops and restaurants are located in an unusual setting. Here, tourists, residents, and motion picture stars enjoy unique shopping and dining. Lines 3, 44 and 89 offer Freeway Flyer service from Downtown Los Angeles to Farmers Market.

**DODGERS AND ANGELS** — The most modern baseball stadium in the world is located on Exposition Street from Downtown Los Angeles.

**HORSE RACING** — Santa Anita Park, in Arcadia, Los Alamitos Race Track in Los Alamitos and Hollywood Park in Inglewood, are served by Special Freeway Flyers during their racing seasons.

**HOLLYWOOD** — Hollywood Boulevard is lined with famous theatres such as Grauman's Chinese, with its forecourt featuring footprints of film stars past and present; the Egyptian; RKO Pantages; and Warner Brothers. Take Line 51 from Downtown L.A.

**HOLLYWOOD BOWL** — Throughout the year various programs appear at the beautiful Hollywood Bowl. During the summer months incomparable "Symphonies Under the Stars" are presented. From Los Angeles take Line 53 on Hill St.
