Metro Bus Detours and Travel Options for Los Angeles Marathon

The Source has posted a reminder that the Los Angeles Marathon is scheduled to take place this upcoming Sunday, March 17, 2013. The event will begin at 6:55 a.m. and is expected to end at around 5:00 p.m. In addition, the marathon will run from Dodger Stadium to the Santa Monica pier. Due to road closures and bus detours, Metro Rail is the best option for those who want to view the marathon as there are nine stations that run along the race course. Metro will also operate free non-stop shuttle service from Culver City Station to Olympic Boulevard/11th Street in Santa Monica during the marathon as an alternative option for those traveling from downtown to the beach. The shuttles will run every 15 minutes from approximately 5:00 a.m. until the conclusion of the race.
