Subject: Message on Upcoming Metro Service Changes from COO Carolyn Flowers

Dear Metro Partner:

In an effort to better serve the needs of our customers, Metro makes adjustments to our bus & rail service twice yearly. The next round of service improvements is scheduled to go into effect beginning Sunday, December 13, 2009 or later. These improvements include some route extensions and modifications, more efficient service on major streets, and the addition of two new lines, Line 902 and the Silver Line. Line 902 will provide new local and limited service connecting the North Hollywood Metro Rail Station and Pacoima, via Van Nuys Blvd and Burbank Blvd. The new Silver Line will offer express service between the El Monte Station, Downtown Los Angeles and the Artesia Transit Center.
