SUBJECT:

TRANSIT SAFETY AND SECURITY PERFORMANCE

ISSUE

This report reflects February 2020 performance data as reported under the transit policing deployment strategy which is a combination of in-house fare compliance officers, private security for fixed assets and a multi-agency law enforcement deployment strategy by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD), and Long Beach Police Department (LBPD). In addition, the report highlights initiatives from the System Security and Law Enforcement department and its efforts to create a safer environment for Metro employees and a safer experience for Metro customers.

BACKGROUND

The System Security and Law Enforcement (SSLE) department entered into a multiagency policing partnership in 2017 to increase the number of police on the Metro system to provide a greater, more visible "felt presence" of police to help deter criminal activity on Metro buses and trains.

DISCUSSION

DEPLOYMENT ANALYSIS AND FORMULA DEVELOPMENT

SSLE has verified the deployments of our law enforcement partners, contract security and Metro Transit Security. In the next thirty days, staff will assess their deployment

strengths, areas for improvement to enhance accountability, and develop a long-term security personal formula to support the continued expansion of Metro's transportation system.

NATIONAL CRIME VICTIMIZATION SURVEY - UPDATE

As requested by Board Chair Butts, staff convened a working group with Metro's Survey Team to explore the idea of implementing a National Crime Victimization Survey (NCVS). Most recently, the Survey Team prepared a draft of the survey and has been shared with SSLE management for feedback. As of March 25th, 2020, the Survey Team is making follow-up revisions to the draft and expects to have the survey available for a test run by May 2020. We will provide another update next month.

COMPLIANCE - MPV UPDATE

In March 2020, Metro staff completed the re-programing and issuance of the MPVs to the law enforcement partners. Metro staff continues to meet weekly with Axiom to discuss issues related to the current map dashboard and review progress of the enhanced map features listed under Modification No. 8 executed in October 2019. On March 17, 2020, Axiom presented a test demo of the enhanced map features but did not work. Metro SSLE tried using the test demo on March 24, 2020 and March 30, 2020, but both times Metro SSLE encountered issues such as network access, map feature missing, and reports not displaying data. The test demo of the enhanced map features has been unsuccessful, the current map dashboard continues to be unreliable, slow and labor intensive to draw information for accountability. SSLE will continue to work with the vendor to ensure contract compliance, and determine if the upgrade will meet the compliance, and accountability requirements needed.

Based on the modification's list of milestones, the enhancement features related to the Map are anticipated to be completed by July 24th and July 31st, 2020. We will update the Board on progress or setbacks.

HOMELESS OUTREACH SERVICES

For updates, please refer to the board report titled "April Quarterly Board Report – Homeless Outreach December 2019 – February 2020" (File ID 2020-0234). SSLE will continue providing a monthly update on homeless outreach services in the following month's board report.

TRANSIT SECURITY HIRING PLAN

Metro's Transit Security (MTS) is a key component in Metro's overarching security efforts. Recruitment and retention of security officers have been an ongoing challenge and even more recently, with an increase in demand for staff assignments, and insufficient staffing levels to meet them.

In November 2019, the hiring process for 90 candidates was stalled due to an internal evaluation of the recruitment test questions. In a month, staff was able to continue the process while making improvements that increased professionalism, efficiency, and

quality of candidates who are offered employment. The following improvements were made:

- Background Certification for MTS personnel to improve knowledge, skills, and establish best business practices. Revised paperwork to improve clarity and professional image.
- Implemented waivers to reduce liability and to support the backgrounds process.
- Coordination with Human Resources resulting in improved communication, standards, and efficiencies.
- Enhanced Intake Meeting process to reduce time and cost associated with the background process while ensuring objectiveness in the disqualification process.
- Created timeline with overlapping processes to maximize efficiencies.
- Established scope of work and standards for background investigations vendors.

It should also be noted that the first half of the recruitment took seven months from start to hire, where (8) TSOIs and (1) Lieutenant were hired. The second half is on track to take four months. Timeline for hiring 20 TSO's has been established with an expected completion date of July 13th. However, with the current concerns of COVID-19 may delay the timelines.

The following are the current TSO-I selection steps:

- Written Test
- Physical Agility Test
- Interview
- Live Scan
- Intake Meeting
- Background Investigation
- Psychological Evaluation
- Medical Examination

We will update the Board on hiring progress and enhanced recruitment practices in our next monthly report.

SEXUAL HARASSMENT INITIATIVES

SSLE leadership has requested its law enforcement partners to increase sexual harassment-related calls to a priority Code 2 call to reduce response times. With this revised approach, law enforcement will receive the calls quicker and can reduce response times and determine if a crime has occurred. Those incidents of harassment that have not yet risen to the level of a crime, can be documented in the Transit Watch mobile application.

SSLE is in the development stage of an incident intake process by using Transit Watch for law enforcement to document incidents and share suspect information to develop leads and clear existing cases that may have been committed by the same suspects. In one such case, LAPD Transit Services Division detectives were able to provide

detectives from Central Division with information that assisted them in an arrest of a suspect for another crime.

In addition, SSLE is working with Metro's Women and Girls' Council, Civil Rights Department and will be incorporating information from Metro's How Women Travel Study and UCLA Researchers to develop sexual harassment training for all officers working on our systems to be provided at all roll calls. Lastly, we will be enhancing our MPVs to include a script on how law enforcement and security should conduct victim interviews.

Staff will report back to the Board with an update.

BUS OPERATOR ASSAULTS

In February, there was a total of 5 assaults on bus operators, with 4 assaults occurring in LAPD's jurisdiction and 1 assault occurring in LASD's jurisdiction. Of the 5 assaults, 2 suspects used their hands to strike the bus operators, 1 suspect spat on the bus operator, 1 suspect struck the bus operator with a bag full of recyclables, and 1 suspect sprayed pepper spray in the bus, affecting the bus operator.





Crimes Against Persons, Property, and Society





Average Emergency Response Times




Average emergency response time was 4.79 mins.











Average Emergency Response Times



Percentage of Time Spent on the System




Percentage of Time Spent on the System as a Whole



Ratio of Staffing Levels vs Vacant Assignments




Grade Crossing Operations
