

POLICE DISPATCH AND RESPONSE TIMES



Attached is the February 1995 Metro Blue Line Law Enforcement Activities Report. A summary of significant data and trends follows:

CITATIONS ISSUED

A total of 1,629 citations were issued during the month of February. This totals 104 more citations, for a 6.82% increase from January's total.

Officers issued 776 fare-related citations; this represents 47.64% of the monthly total.

A total of 1,148 passengers were given fare warnings.

Detailed citation information is outlined on pages 4, 5 and 6.

FARE ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

Approximately 316,548 passengers were inspected for proper payment of fare. This represents 38.60% of the estimated 820,250 passengers during the month of February.

ARRESTS

A total of 34 misdemeanor and 16 felony arrests were made during the month of February.

Of the 50 arrestees, 45 were adults and 5 juveniles.

Pages 1 and 2 of the report provides detailed arrest information.

REPORTED CRIMES

A total of 31 crimes (**19 Part I Crimes**) were reported during the month of February, this represents an increase of 34.79% from January's total.

Of the 31 reported crimes, 24 (77.42%) occurred "on rail property," 4 (12.90%) "adjacent to rails," and 3 (9.68%) "away from the rail."

Reported crime information is provided on page 3.

VANDALISM

A total of 3 incidents of vandalism were reported for the month of February.



ARRESTS BY AREA FEBRUARY 1995










FEBRUARY 1995

Total Vehicle Code Citations for Month = 546




BY TIME OF DAY



Total Penal Code Citations for Month = 1,083





CITATIONS ISSUED

A total of 176 citations were issued during the month of February. This totals 85 more citations, for a 93.40% increase from January's total.

Officers issued 110 fare-related citations; this represents 62.50% of the monthly total.

FARE ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

A total of 212,404 passengers were inspected for proper payment of fare. This represents 47.50% of the estimated 447,200 passengers during the month of February.

A total of 881 passengers were given fare warnings.

ARRESTS

A total of 12 misdemeanor and 7 felony arrests were made during the month of February. All of the 19 arrestees were adults.

REPORTED CRIMES


