CITATIONS ISSUED

A total of 1,348 citations were issued during the month of June. This totals 163 less citations, for a 10.79% decrease from May's total. Officers issued 650 fare-related citations; this represents 48.22% of the monthly total. A total of 986 passengers were given fare warnings. Detailed citation information is outlined on page 3.

FARE ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

Approximately 344,086 passengers were inspected for proper payment of fare. This represents 32.03% of the estimated 1,074,200 passengers during the month of June.

ARRESTS

A total of 27 misdemeanor and 8 felony arrests were made during the month of June. All 35 arrestees were adults. Page 2 provides detailed arrest information.

REPORTED CRIMES

A total of 14 crimes (**10 Part I Crimes**) were reported during the month of June; this represents a decrease of 7.69% from May's total. Of the 14 reported crimes, all occurred "on rail property." Reported crime information is provided on page 1.

VANDALISM

A total of 4 incidents of vandalism were reported for the month of June.







CITATIONS ISSUED

On June 28, 1995, David Lindsey of M.I.S. updated our computer database system of the 1995 legislative changes.

A total of 181 citations were issued during the month of June. Officers issued 88 fare-related citations; this represents 48.62% of the monthly total.

FARE ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

Approximately 144,792 passengers were inspected for proper payment of fare. This represents 31.67% of the estimated 457,200 passengers during the month of June.

A total of 486 passengers were given fare warnings.

ARRESTS

A total of 4 misdemeanor and 2 felony arrests were made during the month of June. All of the 6 arrestees were adults.

REPORTED CRIMES

A total of 5 crimes (all **Part I Crimes**) were reported for the month of June; 5 crimes were also reported for the month of May.
