**CITATIONS ISSUED**

A total of 1,532 citations were issued during the month of July. This totals 184 more citations, for a 14% increase from June's total. Officers issued 742 fare-related citations; this represents 48% of the monthly total. A total of 671 passengers were given fare warnings. Detailed citation information is outlined on page 3.

**FARE ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY**

Approximately 300,076 passengers were inspected for proper payment of fare. This represents 32% of the estimated 930,950 passengers during the month of July.

**ARRESTS**

Due to an inconsistent tracking method of arrests utilized by Support Services personnel, an accurate number cannot be given this month. An individual arrested and then cited and released has been tracked as a citation. An "arrest" has been documented as an "arrest" only if the suspect was physically "booked" into a facility. Therefore only a total of 27 arrests were counted during the month of July. According to the arrest log at Blue Line Station, a total of 133 arrests were made. We will correct the tracking system for next month's report. Page 2 provides detailed arrest information of the 27 arrests.

**REPORTED CRIMES**

A total of 9 crimes (4 Part I Crimes) were reported during the month of July; this represents a decrease of 36% from June's total. Of the 9 reported crimes, all occurred "on rail property." Reported crime information is provided on page 1.

**VANDALISM**

A total of 5 incidents of vandalism were reported for the month of July.





## **METRO RED LINE ACTIVITIES REPORT**

### **CITATIONS ISSUED**

A total of 231 citations were issued during the month of July. Officers issued 124 fare-related citations; this represents 54% of the monthly total.

### **FARE ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY**

Approximately 163,124 passengers were inspected for proper payment of fare. This represents 32% of the estimated 503,700 passengers during the month of July. A total of 493 passengers were given fare warnings.

### **ARRESTS**

Due to an inconsistent tracking method of arrests utilized by Support Services personnel, an accurate number cannot be given this month. An individual arrested and then cited and released has been tracked as a citation. An "arrest" has been documented as an "arrest" only if the suspect was physically "booked" into a facility. Therefore only a total of 7 arrests were counted during the month of July. We will correct the tracking system for next month's report.

### **REPORTED CRIMES**

A total of 3 crimes (2 Part I Crimes) were reported for the month of July; this represents a decrease of 40% from June's total. All 3 of the reported crimes occurred "on rail property."
